



2012 Halloween Spooktacular & Monster Mash

Q: When and where is the Halloween Spooktacular?

A: *When:* Thursday, October 25 from 3:30 – 8:30 p.m.

Where: The Dublin Community Recreation Center and the Event Lawn in Coffman Park.

Q. Where do I park?

A. Parking is available within walking distance:

- At the DCRC, 5600 Post Rd.
- Coffman Park parking lots
- Coffman High School North and South lots located on the corner of Tara Hill and Coffman Rd.
- Dublin Coffman High School parking lots
- *FYI: Coffman Park Drive is closed at parking lot by the amphitheater*

Q. How much does it cost?

A. All activities are free. Photos are \$4 per child and payment is made directly to DK Photographic.

Q. Should we wear costumes? (Children and adults)

A. Children and adults are welcome to wear costumes.

Q. Is there a costume contest?

A. No, every costume is a winner.

Q. Will the event be cancelled if it rains?

A. No, however, some of the festivities may move inside the DCRC including the Trunk or Treat trail.

Q. Is there food for sale?

A. *Inside the DCRC:*

- Pizza, chips and soft drinks will be sold in Classroom C.
- Subway will be open for business as usual.

Outside on the event lawn:

- Giant Eagle will offer hot dogs, chicken, pulled pork, beverages and more.

Q. When and where is the Monster Mash?

A. *When:* Thursday, October 25 from 6:30 – 8:30 p.m.

Where: Dublin Community Recreation Center (DCRC) Community Hall.

Q. Will the Monster Mash be chaperoned?

A. Yes, staff members and volunteers will serve as chaperones.

Q. Where are students to be dropped off and picked up for the Monster Mash?

A. At the west entrance of the DCRC by the flag pole.

Q. Who may attend the Monster Mash and is ID needed?

A. Any Dublin resident that is a middle school student with a valid student ID. Students *must* have student ID to enter the Monster Mash.

Q. Is there a fee for the Monster Mash?

A. There is no fee to enter the Monster Mash, but food and soft drinks may be purchased if desired.

Q. Is there a costume contest for the Monster Mash?

A. No, but students may dress in appropriate costumes if they wish.
