

City of Dublin Streets and Utilities Request for Proposal for 2012 Bridge Maintenance

General Specifications:

The City of Dublin Streets and Utilities Division is requesting proposals to complete cleaning and sealing of 1,320 square yards of concrete walls and sidewalks on the bridge over the Scioto River between Dublin Road and Riverside Drive. A minor quantity of cosmetic concrete repair is included in this project as well.

The 2012 Bridge Maintenance Project addresses the cleaning, patching and sealing of approximately 1,326 square yards of concrete surfaces including sidewalks, barrier walls, parapet walls, pilasters and limestone caps. Approximately 100 square feet of minor cosmetic concrete repair/patching is included in this project as well.

Work not included in this project is as follows:

1. Exterior parapet wall not reachable from sidewalk.
2. Painting of the steel bridge handrails.
3. All existing stamped concrete.
4. Bridge Deck Surface

The Contractor awarded this work must enter into a contract to complete the work listed in these specifications. A copy of this agreement is included in this document for review purposes only.

Safety and Insurance:

The Contractor shall be responsible at all times to conduct the work and keep the work site in compliance with federal, state and local safety laws and regulations, including, but not limited to Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) requirements.

The Contractor shall adhere to the requirements for maintaining traffic as indicated in the "Ohio Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways," and the City of Dublin Work Zone Traffic Control Program, latest revision(s). In addition, all personnel must have appropriate clothing such as orange safety vests or shirts with safety reflective materials.

Barricades and Warning Signs: The Contractor will be required to provide, erect, maintain (in proper position, clean, legible and good working condition) and remove all lights, signs, barricades and all other traffic control devices necessary to the maintenance of traffic. All traffic control devices shall conform to Part 7 of the OMUTCD for Streets and Highways as amended, as required under Ohio Revised Code Section 4511.09.

Insurance: Contractor shall have total limits of insurance to include primary and excess coverage in an amount not less than \$2,000,000. (Examples: may be \$1,000,000 primary and \$1,000,000 excess, \$2,000,000 primary, or other equivalent combination.)

Property, Auto and Damage Liability

The Contractor shall secure, and maintain, at his/her own expense, until the completion of the Contract, coverage for any auto, including non-owned and hired autos, with a combined single limit of \$1,000,000 per occurrence.

The Contractor shall be responsible for any and all damage to the City of Dublin roadways, curbs, signage, trees and any other public or personal property damage that occurs in completing work on this project.

Worker's Compensation Insurance

Before beginning work, the Contractor shall furnish to the City satisfactory proof that he/she has, for the period covered under the Contract, full Worker's Compensation coverage for all persons whom he/she may employ directly, or through subcontractors, in carrying out the work contemplated under the Contract, and shall hold the City free and harmless for all personal injuries of all persons whom the Contractor may employ directly or through subcontractors.

Prevailing Wage

The current prevailing wage threshold for this work is \$24,609.00. In the event proposals to complete this work equal or exceed \$24,609.00, then prevailing wage rates must be paid.

Qualifications

Contractors **must demonstrate and submit with proposal** a minimum of three consecutive years of experience completing concrete sealing and repair work equal to or greater than the scope of this project.

Contractors **must submit with proposal** at least three examples of past work of a similar nature within the past three years successfully completed.

Contractors **must submit with proposal** five professional references from previously completed similar work.

Upon request, contractors must provide a written safety program suitable to the Director of Streets and Utilities.

Upon request, contractors shall provide proof of work zone and traffic control training of all employees working on this project.

Proposal Process

The contractor will submit the information requested in the Proposal Form attached to this Request for Proposals, along with any other information requested herein.

Complete specifications are available for viewing and on CD at the address listed below Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. until the deadline for receipt of proposals. There is no cost for

Proposals must be clearly marked: **Proposal for 2012 Bridge Maintenance.**

All proposals must be received by Wednesday, October 17, 2012 at 3 p.m. local time.

The proposal shall be prepared and submitted in accordance with these instructions. Any omission or limitation to the Proposal may be sufficient grounds for non-acceptance of the response, at the sole discretion of the City.

By submitting its Proposal, the Contractor agrees that Dublin's determination of which Proposal best serves the interest of Dublin shall be final and conclusive, and that if the Contractor or any person on its behalf challenges such determination in any legal proceeding, the Contractor will indemnify and hold Dublin and its employees and agents harmless from any claims included or related to such legal proceeding, whether or not proven, and from legal fees and expenses incurred by Dublin, its employees, or agents that arise out of or are related to such challenge.

Acceptance or Rejection of Proposal: The City reserves the right to accept or reject any or all proposals received as a result of this request. The City also reserves the right to waive any informality, technical defect or clerical error or irregularity in any Proposal. Additionally, the City may, for any reason, decide not to award an agreement as a result of this Proposal. The City reserves the right to cancel this request for proposal. The City shall not be obligated to respond to any responses submitted, nor be legally bound in any manner by the submission of the Proposal.
