The Parade consists of the high school band, cheerleaders, homecoming court, sport groups, club groups, floats, elementary groups, middle school groups, the Dublin City Schools

administration and Board of Education representatives, administrators, and parents all working together to form a parade group in support of the Homecoming weekend, football game, Jerome High School, and the entire school community. Attendance increases each year. Brand Road is lined with spectators as the parade progresses down the route. The Senior Class works with the City of Dublin to sponsor the parade. City services are needed, and police services are needed to close Brand Road to the public and provide parade direction.
