Participants



The Dublin Soccer League is THE community recreational soccer provider, having served over 24,000 participants during the last fifteen years alone.

- Over 98% of the participants reside in the Dublin School District and/or City of Dublin.

The DSL served 2155 participants playing on 202 teams during fall 2012 season and estimates over 2400 players for spring 2013.

- In fall 2012 the DSL was fortunate to have 321 volunteer coaches.

DSL Recreation Program – Ages 5 through 12

- \$95 full year / \$70 one season (Timbits ages U5 and Timbits Jrs. U4 \$85 full season / \$60 one season)
- 8 game fall season / 7 game spring season
- Mini-tournament spring season for U10 & U11/12 teams
- Uniform t-shirt and socks provided
- Saturday morning games
- Once a week practice
- Volunteer coaches

Middle School Program – Ages 12 through 15

- With uniform, \$135 full year / \$95 one season
- Without uniform, \$110 full year / \$70 one season
- Uniform jersey and socks
- 10 game season both fall and spring
- Fall & Spring mini-tournament
 - includes a tournament t-shirt for each player
- 2 games & 1 practice per week, limited travel
- Volunteer coaches


Programs & Fees (continued)



High School Program – Ages 15 through 19

- With uniform, \$110 full year / \$75 one season
- Without uniform, \$85 full year / \$50 one season
- 2 t-shirts & a pair of socks
- 8 game fall season / 7 game spring season
- Sunday afternoon games, optional practices, limited travel
- Volunteer coaches

Field and Facility Resource Management

- Coordinate the layout of 47 fields with city personnel for both Darree and Avery Parks
- Maintain (line) playing fields on a regular basis
- Track and coordinate field assignments of all fields at both parks for all soccer programs 24/7 throughout the permit period
- Maintain, repair, and purchase goals and nets, including submitting requests for Dublin Bed Tax Grants
- Oversaw the construction of Storage/Concession Facility at Darree Fields (Bldg. #3)

League Responsibilities

(continued)



- As a league, the DSL is the only entity which can maintain membership in Ohio South Youth Soccer Association and the Mid Ohio Select Soccer League.

As the liaison to these soccer governing bodies, the DSL is officially affiliated with --- and accountable for --- Ohio Premier, Club Ohio and the MOSSL teams of the DSX.

- DSL coordinates and provides the opportunity for high school booster organizations to earn money for their programs by working in the concession stands, allowing these organizations to earn over \$170,000 since 1992.
- The DSL participates in Trunk or Treat and local parades.

Dublin Charity Cup:

Through 2012, our 23rd year, the Charity Cup has contributed over \$500,000 to children's charities, particularly Big Brothers Big Sisters of Central Ohio.



