

Facebook Camp Page Information

We are excited to take our camps to the next level of social media again this year and offer an opportunity for you to see what is happening at the camps each week. Beginning the week of June 10, we will launch our Facebook Camp Pages for the following camps: Wyandot – Wyandot, Wyandot – Scottish Corners, Kidzone, and My First Camp.

Any parents interested in viewing their child's camp page will need to send a request on Facebook to the appropriate camp to be added as a friend.



The Camp Pages will contain photos taken during the week at each of the camps and set up into albums you can easily view. We will do our best to add updates to the pages with important information and reminders as well. Most photos and updates will be added on Fridays.

These pages will be set up securely, so:

1. Only parents with children currently enrolled in a camp will be able to view the content (ie: if your child is registered for My First Camp, you are not able to view material on the Kidzone page). Children may not request to be added to any camp pages.
2. Privacy controls will be set so it will not show the list of Facebook friends who are in the group.
3. Posting comments or accepting friend requests from any camp parents or children is prohibited of our summer camp staff.
4. Photos will not be tagged.
5. Comments on the photos and updates posted will be reviewed by the PSY Program Coordinator and removed if deemed inappropriate.
