

**Architectural Review Board Application  
Statement**


This application is for building a stone wall along the northern 140 ft (approx.) of the Dublin Road street frontage of the property at 8055 Dublin Road.

There is an existing dry-stone wall along most of the Dublin Road street frontage of this property. This wall was included in the site inventory when the property was placed on the National Register of Historic Places. It is believed that similar walls previously continued along Dublin Road from the present wall.


The existing wall is constructed of locally quarried limestone and is similar to other stone walls along Dublin Road and elsewhere in the area. The proposed new section of wall will closely approximate the material, appearance, and dimensions of the existing wall (approximately 2ft 6in high and 1ft 6in wide).

Note that the existing wall is within the right-of-way. The new section of wall would follow the same line as the existing wall, except for two small indentations around existing trees, and would therefore also be within the right-of-way, as shown on the attached plan.








