I-270 & US 33 Northwest Interchange Aesthetics

Addendum #1

Issued August 15, 2013

In response to recent inquiries, the City of Dublin is providing this additional information to prospective respondents to the I-270/U.S. 33 Northwest Interchange Aesthetics Request for Proposals.

Budget: A budget has not been established for the project. The City of Dublin expects the consultant to assist in development budget estimates. Preliminarily, the City Administration is targeting \$600,000 for landscape and hardscape, and \$300,000 for artwork. These targets will be evaluated in conjunction with concept design.

Scope: The primary focus of the consultant's work will be in the interchange area. This area is designated as east of Emerald Parkway, south of Post Road, west of Frantz Road, and north of Innovation Drive. The determination of expansion of the project scope to areas along the U.S. 33 Corridor to the west will not be considered with the project at this time.

Irrigation: Irrigation is advisable with the project. The source of water should be water wells within the interchange. There is the potential for use of reclaimed water from a proposed pump station in the northeast quadrant of the interchange as well. The successful consultant will be provided specifications for irrigation system components.

Page Size: It is permissible to utilize 11"x17" size pages for a portion or all of a proposal.

Permits: It is not anticipated that Proposal Part 1 will require permits. Future right of way permit(s) from the Ohio Department of Transportation will be determined once conceptual design is reviewed.

Artwork: Artwork will, at minimum, be created as bas relief through the use of custom designed concrete form liners for use in retaining walls, bridges parapets and piers.

Presentations: Consultant should anticipate one presentation to Ohio Department of Transportation, CH2M Hill, City of Dublin, and other stakeholders of the concept plan.

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
