RE: Campaign Signs in Historic Dublin

A candidate recently requested clarification about the placement of campaign signs in Historic Dublin. The following response was provided.

In Historic Dublin the placement of campaign signs is permissible on private property as in other areas of the City. For example: If public right-of-way extends to a structure the campaign sign may be placed on the structure to include an open or covered deck or porch. Also, green space maintained by the property owner such as a landscape feature or grassed area is permissible.

Determining right-of-way is difficult in many areas and the public GIS map will not give exact information. Staff suggest viewing the information provided in the candidate packet that shows permitted/prohibited locations. Also, if there is difficulty in determining if a location is permissible Code Enforcement will gladly meet with either the candidate or a representative on site and identify the appropriate area.
