RE: Security Protocol documents from Dublin Springs

A candidate inquired about whether Dublin Springs has submitted documentation or a safety plan to the City of Dublin.

The City has not received a safety plan from Dublin Springs. Dublin Springs is not required to provide a written plan to the City. The City's command Police staff have met multiple times with representatives of the facility prior to and after its opening to discuss security and the response protocol of law enforcement to the location. These discussions have included how the Dublin Police will respond to calls for service for patients who are classified as dangerous to themselves or others. Also, Dublin Springs has indicated that a vast majority of its patients voluntarily seek treatment and in turn may voluntarily choose when to stop treatment at the facility.

In recent weeks, additional meetings have occurred to refine how calls for assistance are placed and the response by Dublin Police. There has also been meetings with Planning staff to discuss possible site modifications that would enhance security. This remains under administrative review right now.
