Re: Resolution No. 24-15 - Authorizing the City Manager to Enter into a Letter of Agreement with AT&T Ohio to Relocate Aerial Facilities to Underground Facilities in Conjunction with the Construction of the SR 161/Riverside Drive Intersection Improvement

Summary

The City of Dublin ("City") is preparing to improve the intersection of State Route 161 and Riverside Drive ("Project"). The Project provides for the construction of a multi-lane roundabout with appropriate pedestrian facilities. The southbound bypass lane will be retained and a shared use path will be incorporated in the underpass area to provide a north/south connection adjacent to the river. The Project also builds a shared use path connection on the east side of Riverside Drive between the intersection and Martin Road.

Staff has worked closely with AT&T Ohio ("AT&T") to design and relocate aerial AT&T facilities along Riverside Drive south of SR 161 as part of the Project. The City is working to eliminate overhead utility facilities in and around the Project. At the request of the City, AT&T has agreed to relocate approximately 1,000 feet of aerial facilities to underground facilities along Riverside Drive between SR 161 and Martin Road.

The estimated cost to perform this relocation is \$216,266.61. Since this relocation is desirable for the construction of the Project, but not essential, the associated costs are compensable.

Recommendation

Staff recommends approval of Resolution 24-15, authorizing the City Manager to enter into a Letter of Agreement in substantially the same form as attached, accept the estimated design and relocation costs, and authorize AT&T to advance utility relocation in order to build the Project.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A LETTER OF AGREEMENT WITH AT&T OHIO TO RELOCATE AERIAL FACILITIES TO UNDERGROUND FACILITIES IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE SR 161/ RIVERSIDE DRIVE INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENT

WHEREAS, the City of Dublin's adopted 2015-2019 Capital Improvements Program includes the construction of the SR 161/Riverside Drive Intersection Improvement; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dublin has worked closely with AT&T Ohio to relocate AT&T Ohio facilities along Riverside Drive between SR 161 and Martin Road in conjunction with the SR 161/Riverside Drive Roundabout; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dublin has agreed to assume one hundred percent (100%) of the costs to relocate the aerial facilities to underground facilities as the relocation is requested as part of the effort to eliminate overhead utility facilities between SR 161 and Martin Road along Riverside Drive.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Dublin, _____ of its elected members concurring, that:

Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a Letter of Agreement with AT&T Ohio for the payment of one hundred percent (100%) of the costs to relocate aerial facilities underground along Riverside Drive between SR 161 and Martin Road, in substantially the same form as attached, with changes not inconsistent with this Resolution and not substantially adverse to this City and which shall be approved by the City Manager and Director of Finance. The approval of changes thereto by those officials, and their character as not being substantially adverse to the City, shall be evidenced conclusively by their execution thereof.

Section 2. The City Manager, the Clerk of Council, the Director of Law, the Director of Finance, Director of Public Service, Director of Engineering or other appropriate officers of the City are hereby authorized to prepare and sign all agreements and instruments and to take any other actions as may be appropriate to implement this Resolution. The City Manager and the Director of Finance are also authorized, for and in the name of the City, to execute any amendments to the Pipeline Relocation Agreement, which amendments are not inconsistent with the Resolution and not substantially adverse to this City.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect upon adoption in accordance with Section 4.04(a) of the Revised Charter.

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Staff has worked closely with AT&T Ohio ("AT&T") to design and relocate aerial AT&T facilities along Riverside Drive south of SR 161 as part of the Project. The City of Dublin is working to eliminate overhead utility facilities in and around the SR 161 / Riverside intersection. At the request of the City of Dublin, AT&T has agreed to relocate approximately 1000 feet of aerial facilities to underground facilities. The relocation is located between SR 161 and Martin Road along Riverside Drive in the City of Dublin, Ohio.

AT&T Ohio provided an estimate of \$216,266.61 including plant labor, engineering, material and right-of-way costs. The City of Dublin accepts this estimate and understands that the City will be billed for actual costs incurred.
