I am a current resident of Park Place and although I welcome the development of Autumn Rose Farm I have a concern regarding the impact of this development on the present green space.

Both the options presented by Putle Homes impact the current green space (or trees/woods) to some extent. In the past the city during its future land use planning sessions had decided to retain all of the present green space. Concepts where there would be a corridor from Hyland Croy to the green space was envisioned.

It would be unfortunate if the city decided to reduce this green space to accommodate residential homes. The city has been prudent in the development of city land and I would encourage you and other city planners to consider retaining all of the present green space on the Means/Griffith property.

The city has limited greens space/woods left and retaining what we have is high desirable.
