Re: McCormack & Taylor, LLC DBA Green Olive Company
Application for New D2 Liquor Permit

I. INTRODUCTION

The City of Dublin recently received a Notice to Legislative Authority (“Notice”) from the Ohio Division of Liquor Control concerning McCormack & Taylor, LLC DBA Green Olive Company (“Green Olive”). Dublin has received this Notice pursuant to R.C. 4303.26 because Green Olive has applied for a new liquor permit and the proposed location for the permit premises will be located within the corporate limits of Dublin. As such, Dublin may request a hearing regarding the advisability of the issuance, transfer of ownership, or transfer of location of the permit.

II. BACKGROUND

Green Olive is a domestic limited liability company that is actively registered with the Ohio Secretary of State. The address designated for the permit premises is 36 N. High Street, Suite A, Dublin, Ohio 43017, which is located on North High Street just north of West Bridge Street. Green Olive is seeking to obtain a D2 liquor permit, which permits sale of wine and mixed beverages for on premises consumption or in original sealed containers for carry out until 1:00am. Green Olive’s application is currently pending before the Ohio Division of Liquor Control (the “Division”).

III. RECOMMENDATION

According to the Division’s records, Green Olive does not have a history of violating Ohio liquor permit laws.

It would appear that it is unnecessary to request a hearing in this matter. Green Olive does not have a history of liquor law violations. Regardless whether Dublin desires to request a hearing, the Notice must be signed and returned to the Ohio Division of Liquor Control by May 23, 2016.

D2	\$564	ORC 4303.14 Wine and mixed beverages for on premises consumption or in original sealed containers for carryout only until 1:00am.

4303.14 D-2 permit.

Permit D-2 may be issued to the owner or operator of a hotel, of a retail food establishment or a food service operation licensed pursuant to Chapter 3717. of the Revised Code that operates as a restaurant for purposes of this chapter, or of a club, boat, or vessel, to sell wine and prepared and bottled cocktails, cordials, and other mixed beverages manufactured and distributed by holders of A-4 and B-4 permits at retail, either in glass or container, for consumption on the premises where sold. The holder of this permit may also sell wine and prepared and bottled cocktails, cordials, and other mixed beverages in original packages and not for consumption on the premises where sold or for resale. The fee for this permit is five hundred sixty-four dollars for each location, boat, or vessel.
