Focus & Results

Goal #1: Enhance our readiness and demonstrate our ability to effectively respond to and successfully resolve critical incidents, major crimes, and/or issues of significant community concern.

- 31.3% decrease in violent crimes YTD from 2015
- 17.5% increase in reported crimes YTD from 2015

Goal #2: Reduce theft offenses throughout the city.

- 1.0% decrease in theft offenses from 2015 YTD
- 8.3% decrease in thefts from vehicles from 2015 YTD
- 22.9% increase in burglaries and B&Es from 2015 YTD

Goal #3: Improve overall traffic safety in the city.

- 1.0% decrease in traffic crashes from 2015 YTD
- 0.7% increase in injury traffic crashes from 2015 YTD
- 22.2% increase in OVI related traffic crashes from 2015 YTD

Goal #4: Enhance and demonstrate our ability to effectively address drug offenses that contribute to crime affecting the city.

- 116 criminal arrests related to drug activity; 156 drug offense charges YTD








CALLS FOR SERVICE JANUARY 1, 2016 - JUNE 30, 2016





January - June 2016 vs 2015




Auto Accidents





ACCIDENT ANALYSIS April - June 2016

April 1, 2016 through June 30, 2016 there were 239 reported traffic accidents, resulting in an average 2.63 accidents/day. Compared to 2015, accidents increased 2.58% (2016 = 239; 2015 = 233).

Personal injury accidents (64) accounted for 26.78% of the total. Property damage accidents accounted for the majority of our activity with 175 reports being filed (73.22%).


District 5 experienced the majority of accidents (73 or 30.5%) followed by District 2 with 58 accidents (24.3%). There were 44 collisions each in District 1 (18.4%), 16 collision in District 3 (6.7%) and 48 collisions in District 4 (20.1%). The busiest day of the week for accident activity for the reporting period was Tuesday with 45 accidents (18.8%) reported. The second busiest day was Friday with 39 accidents (16.3%) reported. Accident activity for the remaining days of the week were as follows: Sunday = 21 (8.8%); Monday = 38 (15.9%); Wednesday = 37 (15.5%); Thursday = 31 (13.0%); and Saturday = 28 (11.7%).

The most frequent contributing factor was Following Too Closely, which accounted for 95 or 39.7% of the accidents. The next most recurrent contributing factor was Failure To Yield accounting for 46 or 19.2% of the accidents for the reporting period. The busiest time of day for accident activity was between 5PM-6PM with 33 (13.8%) accidents.


Three (3) crashes were identified as having been alcohol related (1.3%). The drivers in these accidents were arrested and charged with OVI. One hundred ninety-seven (197) citations were issued to at fault drivers as a result of their accidents (82.4%).



ACCIDENT ANALYSIS January - June 2016

January 1, 2016 through June 30, 2016 there were 448 reported traffic accidents, resulting in an average 2.48 accidents/day. Compared to 2015, accidents increased 1.36% (2016 = 448; 2015 = 442).

Personal injury accidents (116) accounted for 25.9% of the total. Property damage accidents accounted for the majority of our activity with 332 reports being filed (74.1%).


District 5 experienced the majority of accidents (143 or 31.9%) followed by District 2 with 117 accidents (26.1%). There were 74 collisions in District 1 (16.5%), 27 collisions in District 3 (6.0%) and in District 4, 87 accidents (19.4%). The busiest day of the week for accident activity for the reporting period was Friday with 82 accidents (18.3%) reported. The next busiest day was Tuesday with 77 accidents (17.2%) reported. Accident activity for the remaining days of the week were as follows: Sunday = 36 (8.0%); Monday = 63 (14.1%); Wednesday = 70 (15.6%); Thursday = 70 (15.6%) and Saturday = 50 (11.2%).

The most frequent contributing factor was Following Too Closely, which accounted for 167 or 37.3% of the accidents. The next most recurrent contributing factor was Failure To Control (70 or 15.6%) followed by Failure To Yield accounting for 69 or 15.4% of the accidents for the reporting period. The busiest time of day for accident activity was between 5PM-6PM with 51 (11.4%) accidents.


Ten (10) crashes were identified as having been alcohol related (2.2%). The drivers in these accidents were arrested and charged with OVI. Three hundred sixty-three (363) citations were issued to at fault drivers as a result of their accidents (81.0%).
