




Next you will be prompted with a Print screen, select "Download & Print"



At this point you may see a dialogue box at the bottom of your browser window indicating that pop-ups for the webpage were blocked, you'll need to select "Allow this time" to proceed to the next step.

After working past the prompt for the pop-up you'll need to press "Alt" on your keyboard to bring up the toolbar within Internet Explorer and select "Save as..." from the menu under File
