Description: The Federal-style brick house has a two-story side-gable core with a rear ell. The structure rests on a stone foundation. The roof is sheathed in standing seam metal. The façade is divided into five fenestration bays. The front door is centered on the façade, sheltered by an open gable-roof porch. The door itself is wood-paneled, flanked by sidelights and topped by a transom. Windows on the house are replacements with six-over-six faux muntins; each features a broad stone lintel. Several outbuildings are on the farmstead, including a summer kitchen, garage, garage/workshop, equipment shed, and three-bay English barn.

Setting: The property is on a large lot on the south side of Rings Rd. Cramer ditch extends south of the building complex. Views to neighboring residential properties are largely obscured by tree rows.
