



## INVITATION FOR BIDS

### Project Name: Holder-Wright Park Development

The City of Dublin, Ohio will receive sealed bids for the materials and labor necessary for the construction of a parking lot, small pedestrian bridge, restroom facility, specialized form liner concrete work, sidewalks, grading and shaping earth mounds, and landscape installation for the Holder-Wright Park development. The City of Dublin will deliver these improvements through three (3) separate contracts, more or less focused on 1) the restroom, 2) the pedestrian bridge, and 3) site civil improvements, utilities, grading and landscaping. Bidders may submit bids on one, two or all three contracts. Selected contractors (and their subcontractors) will be required to cooperate and coordinate their activities with each other.

Bids shall be received by the City of Dublin at 6555 Shier-Rings Road, Dublin, Ohio 43016 until 10:00 A.M. local time on Thursday, September 7, 2017 at which time all bids will be publicly opened.

A pre-bid meeting will be held at the Dublin Service Center located at 6555 Shier-Rings Road, Dublin, Ohio 43016 on Monday, August 28, 2017 at 11:00 a.m.

Copies of bid specification and contract documents are on file for review at 6555 Shier Rings Road, Dublin, Ohio 43016 between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. (local time), Monday through Friday, beginning Thursday, August 17, 2017. Documents are available online at <http://dublinohiousa.gov/bids-and-requests-for-proposals> at no charge. When downloading bid documents from online you must register as a plan holder to receive any addendums that may be issued.

Each bidder is required to furnish with its proposal a Bid Guaranty in accordance with Section 153.54 of the Ohio Revised Code. Bid security furnished in Bond form shall be issued by a surety company or corporation licensed in the State of Ohio to provide said security. Payment of prevailing wage is required for this contract.

Each proposal must contain the full name of the party or parties submitting the proposal and all person interested therein. Each bidder must submit evidence of its experience on projects of similar size and complexity.

The City of Dublin reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids, to waive any informalities or irregularities in the bidding process and to enter into a contract with the bidder whom, in its opinion, offers the lowest and best bid.

Each bidder must ensure that all employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against based on race, color, religion, sex or national origin.
