Focus & Results

Goal #1: Enhance our readiness and demonstrate our ability to effectively respond to and successfully resolve critical incidents and/or major crimes

- Clearance rate of violent crimes decreased from 2021 by 65.1%
- ≥25.2% decrease in reported crimes YTD from 2021

Goal #2: Reduce theft offenses throughout the city

- ≻15.0% increase in theft offenses from 2021 YTD
- >28.4% increase in thefts from vehicles from 2021 YTD
- ≻10.5% increase in burglaries and B&Es from 2021 YTD


Goal #3: Improve overall traffic safety in the citv

- >3.7% increase in traffic crashes from 2021 YTD
- ≻40.0% increase in serious injury traffic crashes from 2021 YTD
- ≻45.5% decrease in OVI related traffic crashes from 2021 YTD

Goal #4: Enhance and demonstrate our ability to effectively address issues of significant community concern

The department continues to target areas that have seen an increase in theft from vehicle activity, complaints related to parking garages in the Historic Dublin and Bridge Park areas, and continue enforcement efforts throughout the city with traffic and/or speeding concerns.

CALLS FOR SERVICE APRIL 1, 2022 - JUNE 30, 2022




APRIL-JUNE 2022 TOTAL ■APRIL-JUNE 2021 TOTAL

April 1, 2022 through June 30, 2022 the Dublin Police Department received 10,196 total calls for service – 4,539 calls were citizen initiated. The average response time was 6 minutes with an average time of 46 minutes to handle the call.





ACCIDENT ANALYSIS April - June 2022

April 1, 2022 through June 30, 2022 there were 154 reported traffic accidents, resulting in an average 1.69 accidents/day. Compared to 2021, accidents decreased 10.9% (2022 = 154; 2021 = 173).

Personal injury accidents (51) accounted for 33.1% of the total. Property damage accidents accounted for the majority of our activity with 103 reports being filed (66.9%).


District 5 experienced the majority of accidents (47 or 30.5%) followed by District 2 with 37 accidents (24.0%). There were 14 collisions in District 1 (9.1%); 13 collisions in District 3 (8.4%); 31 collisions in District 4 (20.1%); and 12 collisions in District 6 (7.8%). The busiest day of the week for accident activity for the reporting period was Tuesday with 29 accidents (18.8%) reported. The second busiest day was Wednesday with 28 accidents (18.2%) reported. Accident activity for the remaining days of the week were as follows: Sunday = 9 (5.8%); Monday = 23 (14.9%); Thursday = 24 (15.6%); Friday = 24 (15.6%); and Saturday = 17 (11.0%).

The most frequent contributing factor was Following Too Closely which accounted for 40 or 26.0% of the accidents. The next most recurrent contributing factor was Failure To Yield accounting for 26 or 16.9% of the accidents for the reporting period. The busiest time of day for accident activity was tied between 4PM-5PM and 5PM-6PM with 15 (9.7%) accidents each.




ACCIDENTS BY DISTRICT & CLASSIFICATION

ACCIDENT ANALYSIS January - June 2022

January 1, 2022 through June 30, 2022 there were 286 reported traffic accidents, resulting in an average 1.58 accidents/day. Compared to 2020, accidents increased 4.76% (2022 = 286; 2021 = 273).

Personal injury accidents (84) accounted for 29.4% of the total (1 fatal). Property damage accidents accounted for the majority of our activity with 202 reports being filed (70.6%).


District 5 experienced the majority of accidents (87 or 30.4%) followed by District 2 with 71 accidents (24.8%). There were 31 collisions in District 1 (10.8%); 25 collisions in District 3 (8.7%); 54 collisions in District 4 (18.9%); and 18 collisions in District 6 (6.3%). The busiest day of the week for accident activity for the reporting period was Thursday with 55 accidents (19.2%) reported. The second busiest day was Wednesday with 52 accidents (18.2%) reported. Accident activity for the remaining days of the week were as follows: Sunday = 22 (7.7%); Monday = 35 (12.2%); Tuesday = 45 (15.7%); Friday = 45 (15.7%); and Saturday = 32 (11.2%).

The most frequent contributing factor was Following Too Closely which accounted for 71 or 24.8% of the accidents. The next most recurrent contributing factor was Failure To Yield accounting for 45 or 15.7% of the accidents for the reporting period. The busiest time of day for accident activity was between 5PM-6PM with 29 (29%) accidents.


