Agency Quarterly Activity April – June, 2023

Focus & Results

Goal #1: Enhance our readiness and demonstrate our ability to effectively respond to and successfully resolve critical incidents and/or major crimes

- Total Part I violent crimes increased from 2022 YTD (2023=20; 2022=14)
- >Increase in reported crimes YTD from 2022 (2023=755; 2022=577)
- >Successfully responded to changing crime trends identified in the city

Goal #2: Reduce theft offenses throughout the city

- Increase in theft offenses from 2022 YTD (2023=251; 2022=210)
- >Increase in thefts from vehicles from 2022 YTD (2023=129; 2022=105)
- >Increase in thefts of motor vehicles from 2022 YTD (2023=36; 2022=20)
- ➢Increase in burglaries and B&Es from 2022 YTD (2023=29; 2022=23)

Goal #3: Improve overall traffic safety in the citv

- Increase in traffic crashes from 2022 YTD (2023=343; 2022=286)
- No change in serious injury traffic crashes from 2022 YTD (2023=7; 2022=7)
- >Increase in OVI related traffic crashes from 2022 YTD (2023=11; 2022=6)
- ➢Increase in OVI related arrests 2022 YTD (2023=86; 2022=30)

Goal #4: Enhance and demonstrate our ability to effectively address issues of significant community concern

The department continues to target areas that have seen an increase in theft from vehicle activity, complaints related to parking garages in the Historic Dublin and Bridge Park areas, and continue enforcement efforts throughout the city with traffic and/or speeding concerns.






APRIL 1, 2023 - JUNE 30, 2023

City of Dublin - Police Department - Organizational Chart - Standard 11.1.1







ACCIDENT ANALYSIS April - June 2023

April 1, 2023 through June 30, 2023 there were 209 reported traffic accidents, resulting in an average 2.30 accidents/day. Compared to 2022, accidents increased 35.7% (2023 = 209; 2022 = 154).

Personal injury accidents (55) accounted for 26.3% of the total. Property damage accidents accounted for the majority of our activity with 154 reports being filed (73.7%).


District 5 experienced the majority of accidents (65 or 31.1%) followed by District 2 with 61 accidents (29.2%). There were 23 collisions in District 1 (11.0%); 13 collisions in District 3 (6.2%); 27 collisions in District 4 (12.9%); and 20 collisions in District 6 (9.6%). The busiest day of the week for accident activity for the reporting period was Thursday with 40 accidents (19.1%) reported. The second busiest day was Wednesday with 36 accidents (17.2%) reported. Accident activity for the remaining days of the week were as follows: Sunday = 16(7.7%); Monday = 25(12.0%); Tuesday = 32(15.3%); Friday = 35(16.7%); and Saturday = 25(12.0%).

The most frequent contributing factor was Following Too Closely which accounted for 60 or 28.7% of the accidents. The next most recurrent contributing factor was Failure To Yield accounting for 26 or 12.4% of the accidents for the reporting period. The busiest time of day for accident activity was between 3PM-4PM with 23 (11.0%) accidents.




TDENTS BY DISTRICT & CLASSIEICATION

ACCIDENT ANALYSIS January - June 2023

January 1, 2023 through June 30, 2023 there were 343 reported traffic accidents, resulting in an average 1.90 accidents/day. Compared to 2022, accidents increased 19.93% (2023 = 343; 2022 = 286).

Personal injury accidents (94) accounted for 25.2% of the total (2 fatal). Property damage accidents accounted for the majority of our activity with 249 reports being filed (72.6%).


District 5 experienced the majority of accidents (111 or 32.4%) followed by District 2 with 98 accidents (28.6%). There were 31 collisions in District 1 (9.0%); 21 collisions in District 3 (6.1%); 55 collisions in District 4 (16.0%); and 27 collisions in District 6 (7.9%). The busiest day of the week for accident activity for the reporting period was Friday with 64 accidents (18.7%) reported. The second busiest day was Tuesday with 63 accidents (18.4%) reported. Accident activity for the remaining days of the week were as follows: Sunday = 34 (9.9%); Monday = 37 (10.8%); Wednesday = 55 (16.0%); Thursday = 60 (17.5%); and Saturday = 30 (8.7%).


The most frequent contributing factor was Following Too Closely which accounted for 92 or 26.8% of the accidents. The next most recurrent contributing factor was Failure To Yield accounting for 52 or 15.2% of the accidents for the reporting period. The busiest time of day for accident activity was tied between 11AM-Noon and 3PM-4PM with 29 (8.5%) accidents each.

Eleven (11) crashes were identified as having been alcohol related (3.21%). Two hundred seventyeight (278) citations were issued to at fault drivers as a result of their accidents 81.0%
