Focus & Results

Goal #1: Enhance our readiness and demonstrate our ability to effectively respond to and successfully resolve critical incidents and/or major crimes

- Total Part I violent crimes increased from 2022 YTD (2023=27; 2022=25)
- Increase in reported crimes YTD from 2022 (2023=1,162; 2022=936)
- Successfully responded to changing crime trends identified in the city

Goal #2: Reduce theft offenses throughout the city

- Increase in theft offenses from 2022 YTD (2023=375; 2022=327)
- Increase in thefts from vehicles from 2022 YTD (2023=180; 2022=173)
- Increase in thefts of motor vehicles from 2022 YTD (2023=67; 2022=42)
- Increase in burglaries and B&Es from 2022 YTD (2023=37; 2022=31)

Goal #3: Improve overall traffic safety in the city

- Increase in traffic crashes from 2022 YTD (2023=509; 2022=455)
- Decrease in serious injury traffic crashes from 2022 YTD (2023 = 8; 2022=10)
- Increase in OVI related traffic crashes from 2022 YTD (2023=17; 2022=11)
- Increase in OVI related arrests 2022 YTD (2023=132; 2022=65)

Goal #4: Enhance and demonstrate our ability to effectively address issues of significant community concern

The department continues to target areas that have seen an increase in theft from vehicle activity, complaints related to parking garages in the Historic Dublin and Bridge Park areas, and continue enforcement efforts throughout the city with traffic and/or speeding concerns.

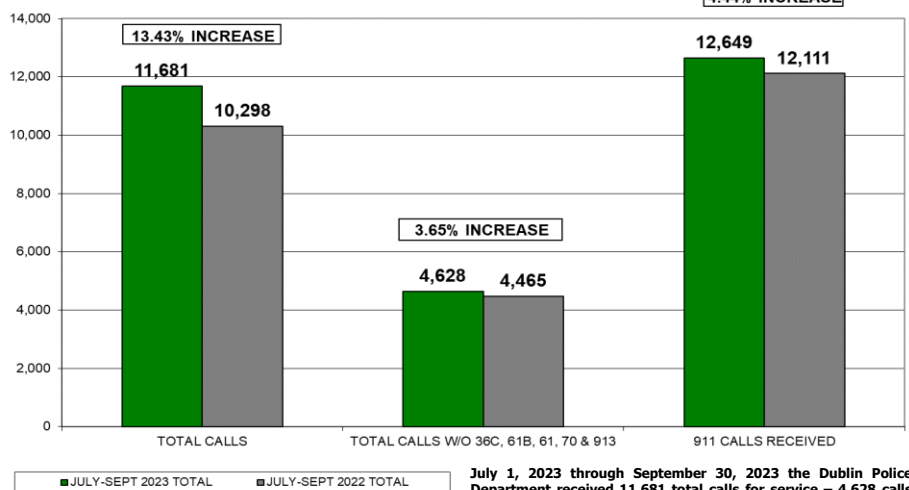

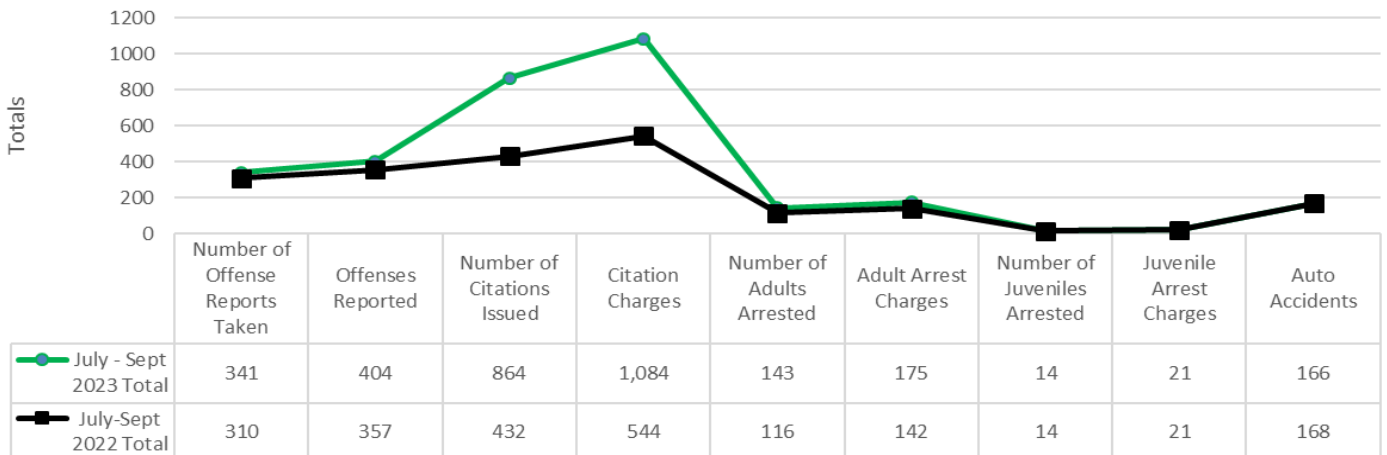
CALLS FOR SERVICE

JULY 1, 2023 - SEPTEMBER 30, 2023

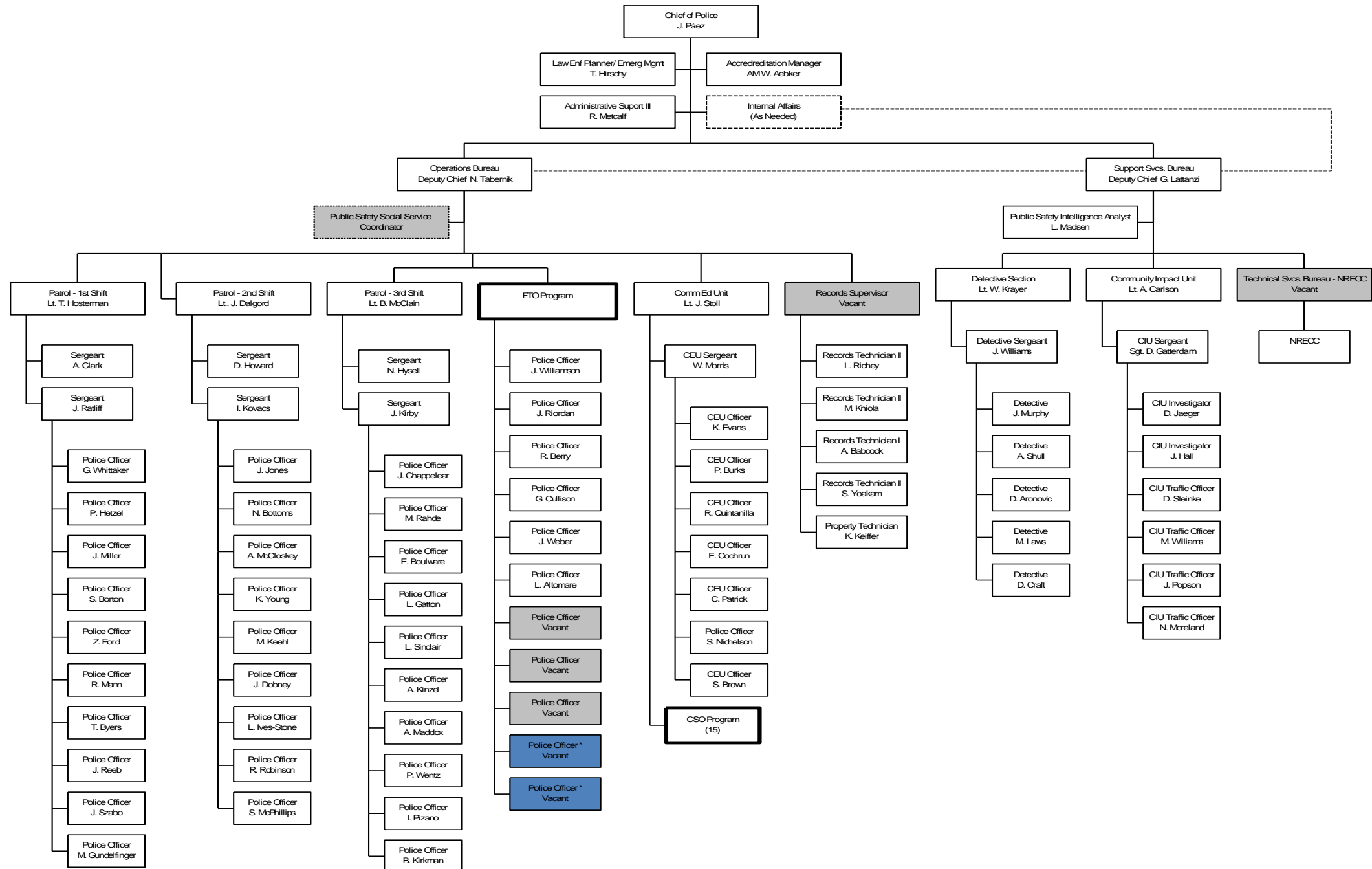

July - September 2023 Other Reported Activity

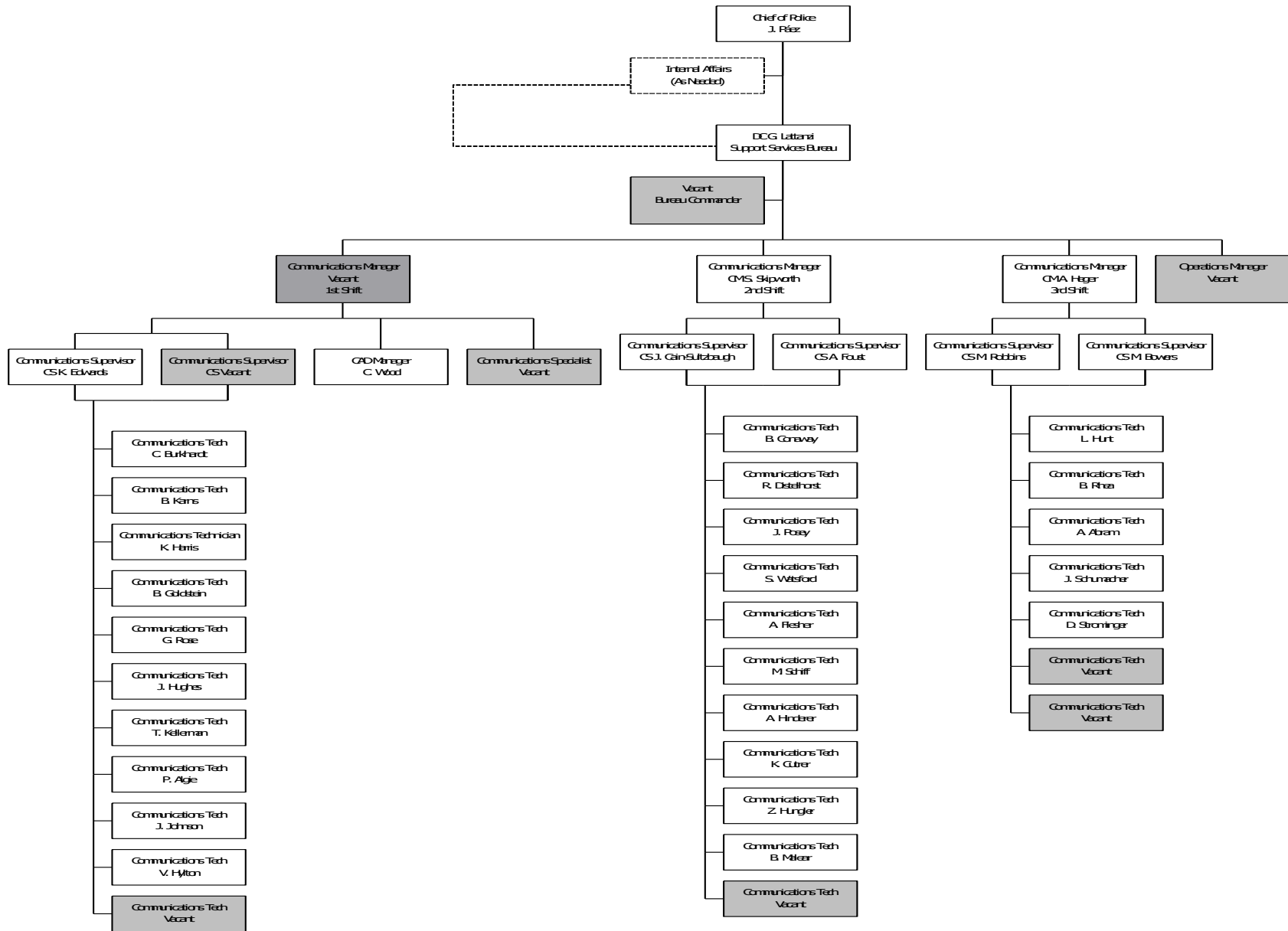


City of Dublin - Police Department - Organizational Chart - Standard 11.1.1

City of Dublin - NRECC - Organizational Chart - Standard 11.1.1



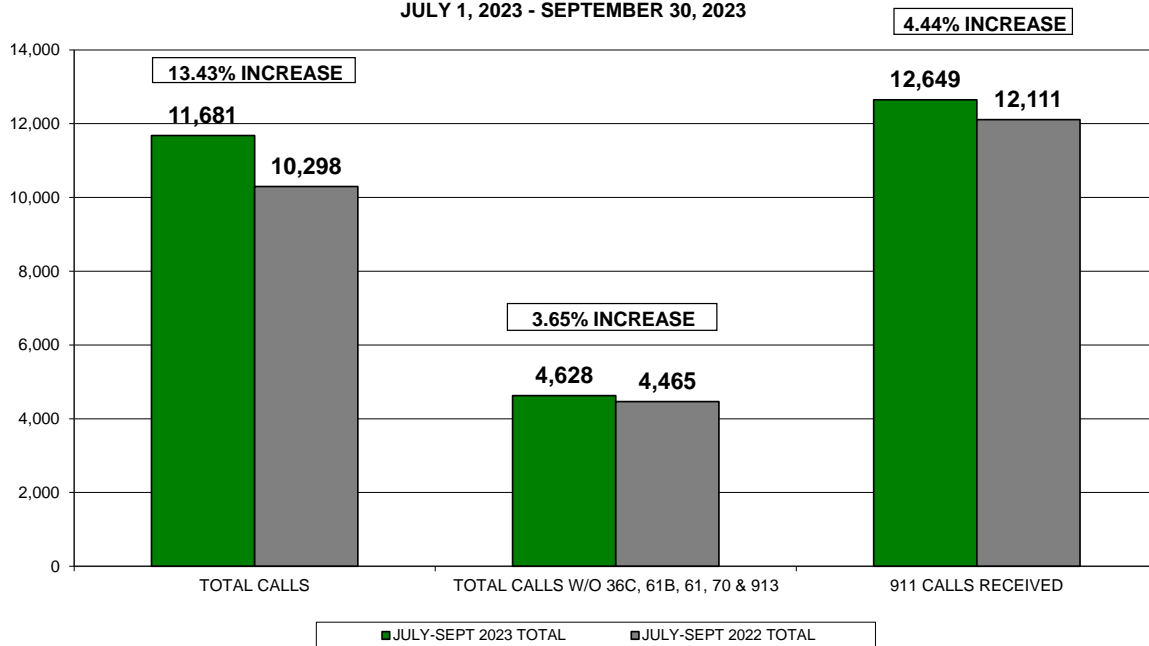

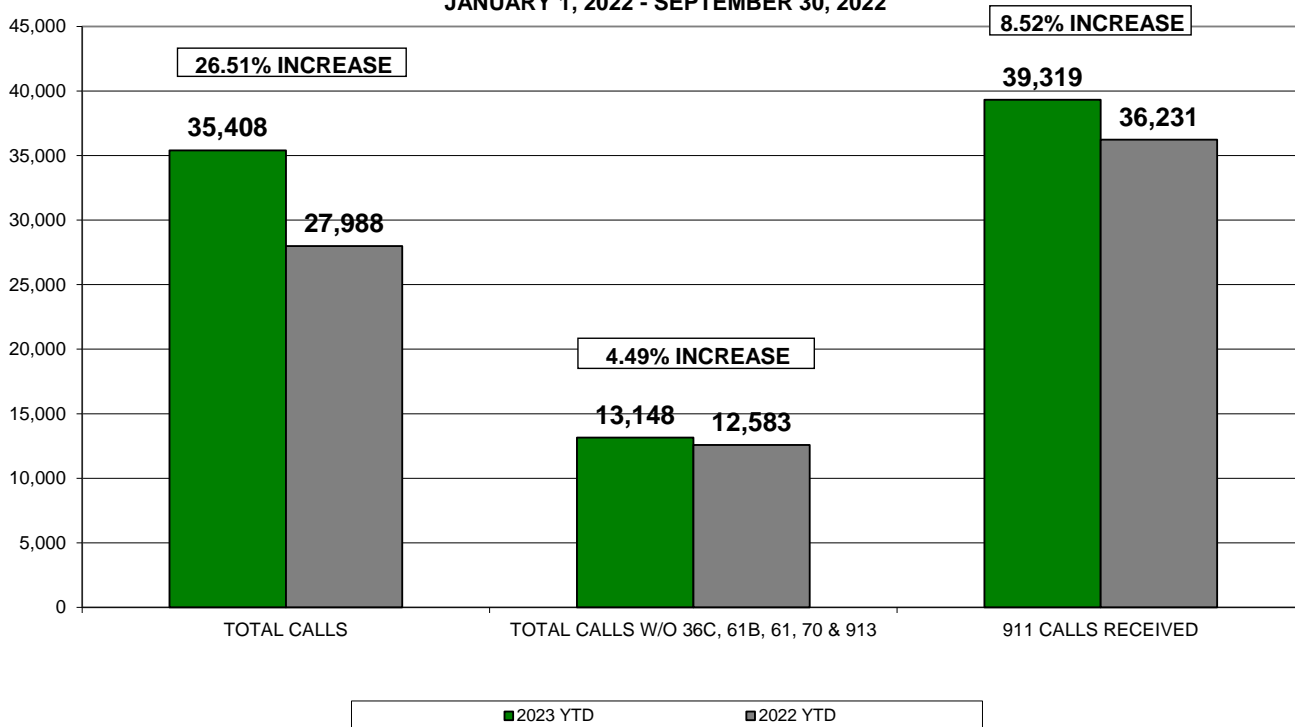

ACCIDENT ANALYSIS July - September 2023

July 1, 2023 through September 30, 2023 there were 166 reported traffic accidents, resulting in an average 1.80 accidents/day. Compared to 2022, accidents decreased 1.19% (2023 = 166; 2022 = 168).

Personal injury accidents (66) accounted for 39.8% of the total. Property damage accidents accounted for the majority of our activity with 100 reports being filed (60.2%).

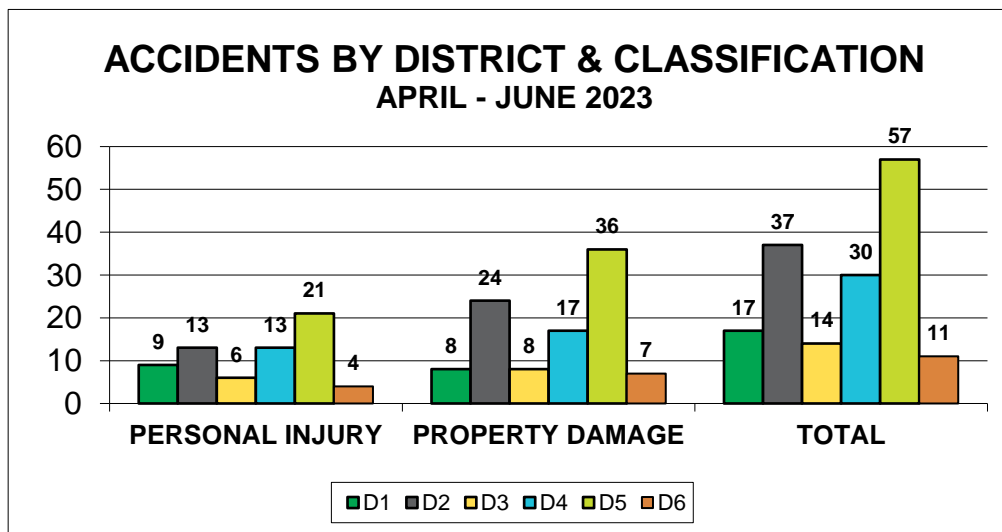
District 5 experienced the majority of accidents (57 or 34.3%) followed by District 2 with 37 accidents (22.3%). There were 17 collisions in District 1 (10.2%); 14 collisions in District 3 (8.4%); 30 collisions in District 4 (18.1%); and 11 collisions in District 6 (6.6%). The busiest day of the week for accident activity for the reporting period was Monday with 31 accidents (18.7%) reported. The second busiest day was tied between Tuesday and Thursday with 28 accidents each (16.9%) reported. Accident activity for the remaining days of the week were as follows: Sunday = 16 (9.6%); Wednesday = 20 (12.0%); Friday = 25 (15.1%); and Saturday = 18 (10.8%).

The most frequent contributing factor was Following Too Closely which accounted for 52 or 31.3% of the accidents. The next most recurrent contributing factor was Failure To Yield accounting for 29 or 17.5% of the accidents for the reporting period. The busiest time of day for accident activity was between 4PM-5PM with 21 (12.7%) accidents.

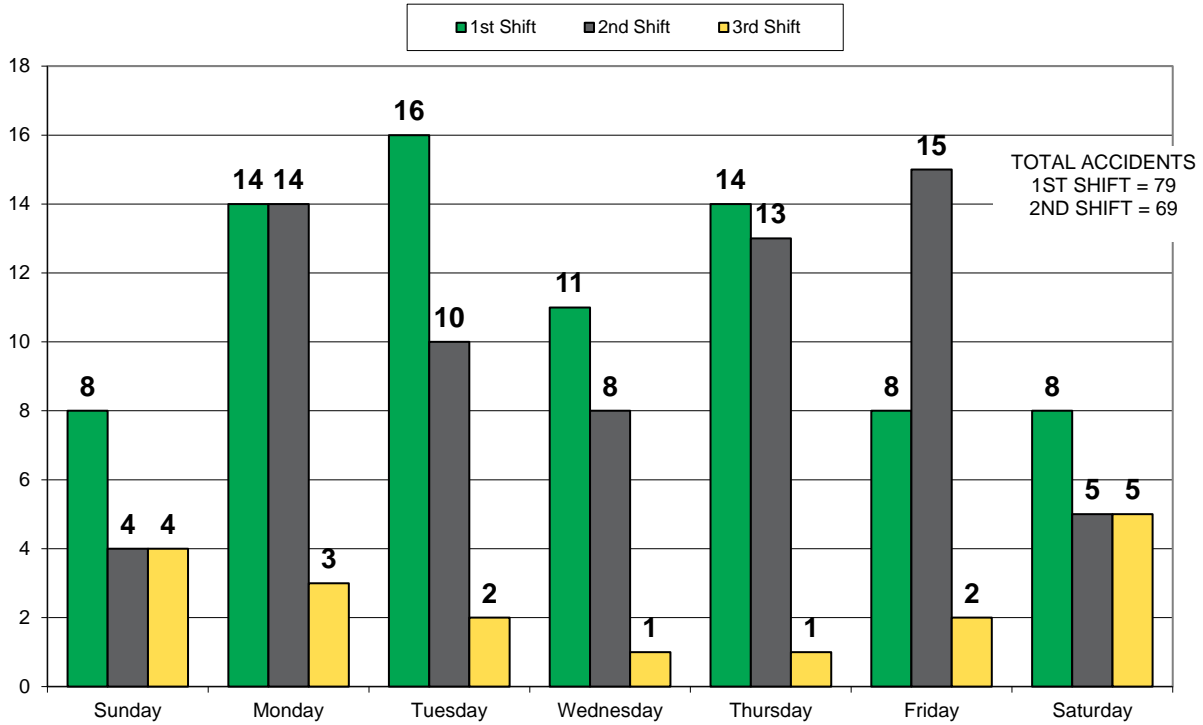

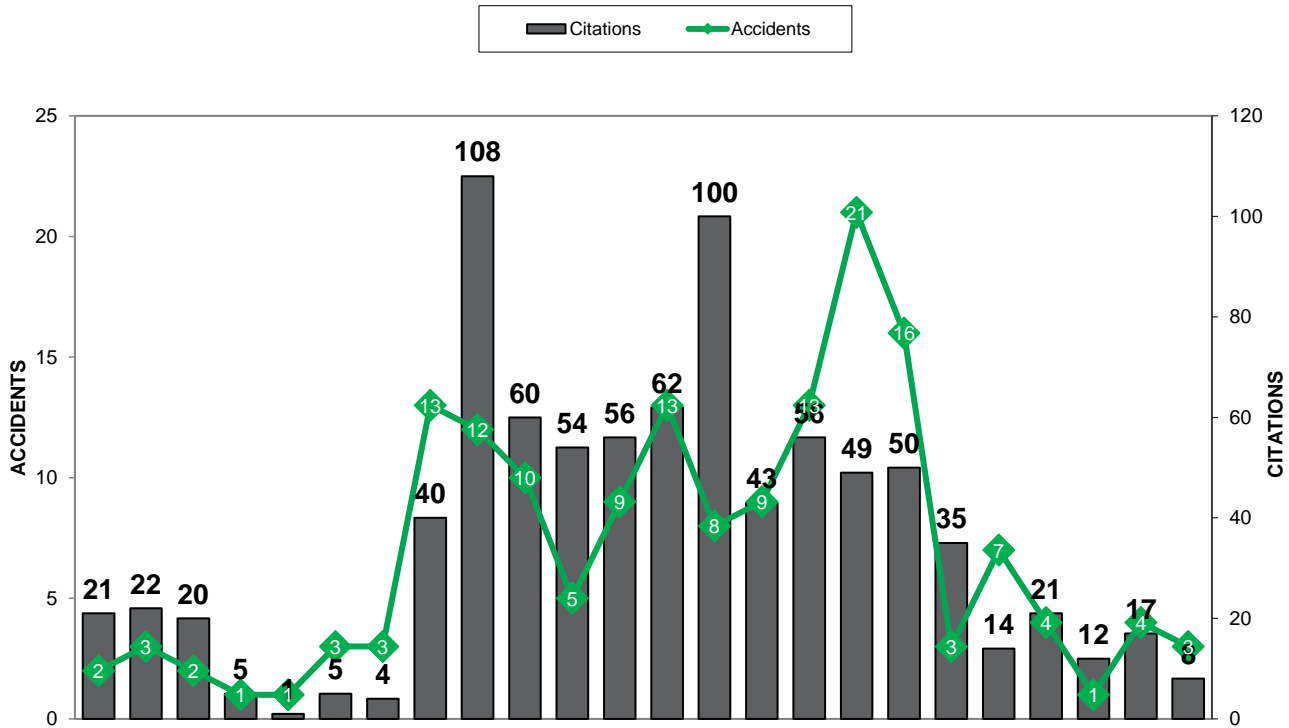

ACCIDENT ANALYSIS January - September, 2023

January 1, 2023 through September 30, 2023 there were 509 reported traffic accidents, resulting in an average 1.86 accidents/day. Compared to 2022, accidents increased 12.11% (2023 = 509; 2022 = 454).

Personal injury accidents (160) accounted for 31.4% of the total (2 fatal). Property damage accidents accounted for the majority of our activity with 349 reports being filed (68.6%).

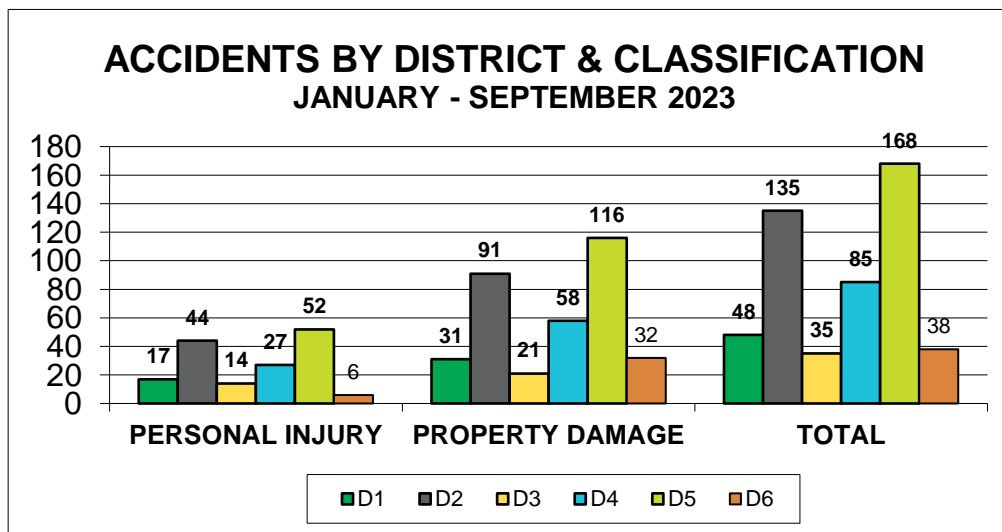
District 5 experienced the majority of accidents (168 or 33.0%) followed by District 2 with 135 accidents (26.5%). There were 48 collisions in District 1 (9.4%); 35 collisions in District 3 (6.9%); 85 collisions in District 4 (16.7%); and 38 collisions in District 6 (7.5%). The busiest day of the week for accident activity for the reporting period was Tuesday with 91 accidents (17.9%) reported. The second busiest day was Friday with 89 accidents (17.5%) reported. Accident activity for the remaining days of the week were as follows: Sunday = 50 (9.8%); Monday = 68 (13.4%); Wednesday = 75 (14.7%); Thursday = 88 (17.3%); and Saturday = 48 (9.4%).

The most frequent contributing factor was Following Too Closely which accounted for 144 or 28.3% of the accidents. The next most recurrent contributing factor was Failure To Yield accounting for 81 or 15.9% of the accidents for the reporting period. The busiest time of day for accident activity was tied between 4PM-5PM with 49 (9.6%) accidents.

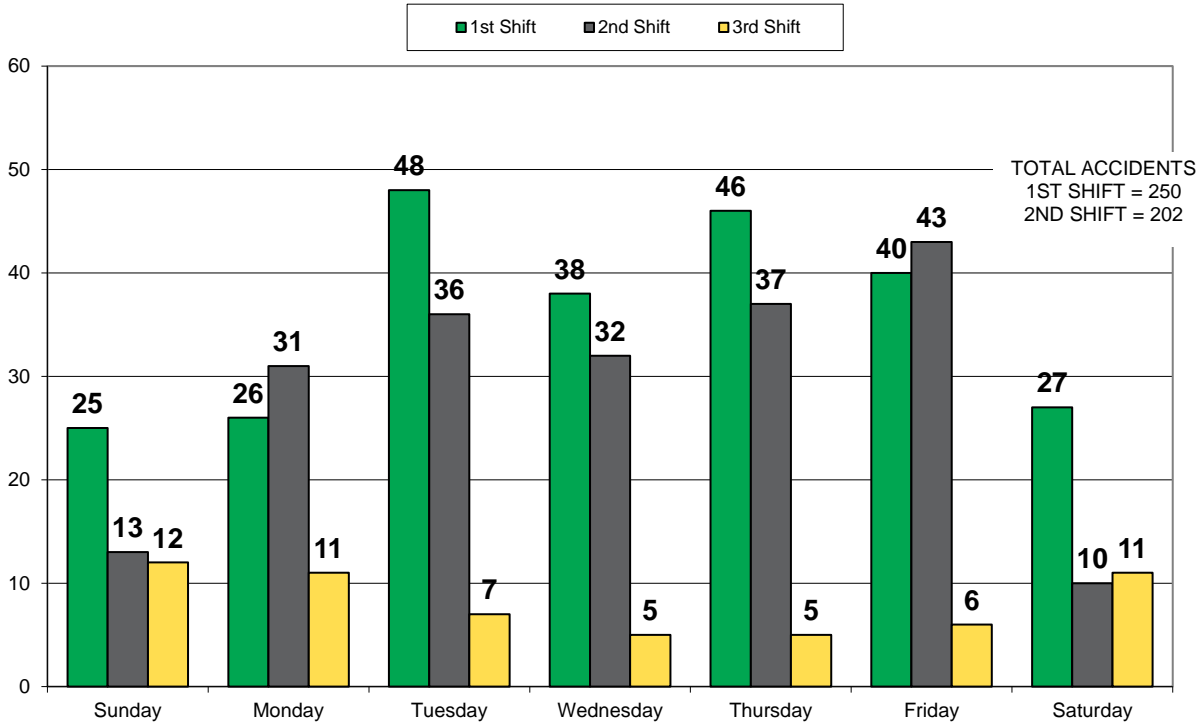
