



LEGACY TREE PROGRAM

LEAVING A LEGACY

The city of Dublin's Legacy Tree program allows families and friends to leave a lasting, living memorial or recognition to loved ones in the form of a tree and plaque.

WHO MAY PARTICIPATE IN THE PROGRAM?

The Legacy Tree program provides residents an opportunity to recognize important occasions such as anniversaries, weddings, births and retirements, as well as to memorialize the loss of a loved one.

WHERE CAN A LEGACY TREE BE PLANTED?

Legacy Trees are planted within City of Dublin parks. Most parks are eligible. City staff will work with those purchasing the tree to determine an appropriate location.

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

The fee of \$1,495 purchases a 1.5-2-inch caliper deciduous tree or a 6-8-foot evergreen. The Legacy Tree also comes with a 9x6 inch bronze plaque with an inscription of your choice.

WHO WILL CARE FOR THE TREE?

The City of Dublin will plant, mulch, water and prune the tree as necessary.

WHAT CAN BE WRITTEN ON THE PLAQUE?

The plaques allow for a maximum of 54 letters including spaces. No logos or artwork are permitted. The City reserves the right to refuse submissions it deems inappropriate.
