

# **Council Candidate Q&A Transparency Posting**

# **Posting No. 2**

To ensure transparency and provide equal access to information for all candidates, the City is posting the following question received from a candidate, along with the City's response. This information is shared exactly as provided so that all candidates have the same access to City resources and clarification.

## **QUESTION SUBMITTED:**

The Candidate Orientation website states \$195 maximum contribution limit for Ward candidates (<a href="https://dublinohiousa.gov/candidate-orientation/">https://dublinohiousa.gov/candidate-orientation/</a>). However, the Dublin Code Sections – Campaign Finance Limits and Disclosure Section 31.07 Campaign Contribution Limits states \$185 (<a href="https://dublinohiousa.gov/alpha/wp-content/uploads/2024/06/Code-Sections-Campaign-Finance-Limits-and-Disclosure.pdf">https://dublinohiousa.gov/alpha/wp-content/uploads/2024/06/Code-Sections-Campaign-Finance-Limits-and-Disclosure.pdf</a>). Can you please confirm which is correct for the 2025 election year.

### **CITY RESPONSE:**

The website is correct. The City passed Ordinance 90-21 in 2021, which requires contribution limits to be adjusted for inflation in each election year. For the 2025 election cycle, the maximum contribution limits are:

- \$195 for Ward candidates
- \$325 for At-Large candidates

The Code Section referenced will be updated to include the most up-to-date information.
