

behind vertical posts. Mr. Salem urged the committee to consider modifications to display the bricks more respectfully.

Mr. Noble acknowledged that this issue had been discussed previously, and the city had re-etched the stones. He explained that major modifications to the park were difficult due to the original artistic design, but smaller changes might be possible, such as placing blank stones near posts and rearranging others for better visibility.

The committee discussed potential solutions, with Mr. Reiner explaining the history of the park design process and the limitations of modifying an artist's design that had won awards. Several ideas were suggested, including a concrete belt to display the bricks at an angle and changing the color of the bricks to make them more visible.

STAFF COMMENTS

Ms. Blake introduced Mara Hunter, a Management Analyst with the City, who will become the new staff liaison to the Veterans Advisory Committee. Ms. Hunter shared her background, noting she started with the city in April, previously worked for the City of Gahanna, and graduated from law school in 2024. She is a Dublin resident who currently supports the development department and finance team.

Ms. Blake thanked Mr. Noble for presenting to City Council about the Veterans Advisory Committee's activities over the past year, noting that Council members were impressed with the committee's work.

ROUNDTABLE


