To ensure transparency and provide equal access to information for all candidates, the City is posting the following question received from a candidate, along with the City's response. This information is shared exactly as provided so that all candidates have the same access to City resources and clarification.

QUESTION SUBMITTED:

Question regarding mosquito spraying and testing program in areas of the City that are within Union County.

CITY RESPONSE:

The City of Dublin works with Franklin County Public Health to run its mosquito management program, which includes trapping and testing mosquitoes for West Nile Virus and using larvicide to control populations before they mature. Spraying occurs only when mosquito counts are unusually high or a positive West Nile Virus test is found. Franklin County Public Health also manages trapping, testing, resident concerns, and advance notifications about spraying.
