To prospective respondents: the following information shall be used to clarify parts of the request for proposals.

1. The RFP says the consultant will be selected by May 2025, which does not align with the proposal due date. Can you confirm the anticipated project kick-off and consultant selection timeline?
The date of May 2025 is a typo. The Schedule section of the RFP accurately lists the anticipated consultant selection to be the week of November 17.
2. Dublin residents have access to drop-off food waste composting and other specialty diversion programs. Does the City intend to explore the food waste curbside composting pilot as part of this project (defined in the 2025 Dublin Sustainability Plan, page 95)? If yes, will collection to multi-family housing units be included in this pilot program?
Curbside composting is not within the scope of this project.
3. When do the City's hauling contracts for curbside recycling and waste hauling services expire? This will help the selected consultant determine best recommendations for the contract negotiations, as defined in "3. Program Integration and Cost Analysis."
The City is part of a consortium. The current consortium contract is under bid through the Solid Waste Authority of Central Ohio. The next contract will be for the term January 1, 2027 – December 31, 2031.
4. What is the City of Dublin's definition of a multifamily parcel (e.g. "5+ dwelling units") for this project?
Per § 153.002 of the City's Code of Ordinances, a multiple-family dwelling is defined as "a building arranged or intended for three or more households living independently of each other in separate dwelling units, any two or more of which may be provided with a common entrance or hall. Dwellings located on upper stories of a structure with non-residential uses on other stories are included in the definition of multiple-family dwelling."
5. How many total multifamily parcels/properties are in the City and included in this project?
As part of the scope of work for this project, the successful respondent will "identify all multifamily complexes in Dublin and the number of units at each"
6. Please describe any prior efforts the City has made to establish multifamily recycling.
To the Staff's knowledge, there have been no prior efforts to establish multifamily recycling by the City of Dublin.
