Bids shall be received by the City of Dublin via the Bid Express ® service at [www.bidexpress.com](http://www.bidexpress.com) until 10:00 A.M. local time on January 20, 2026. Bid documents will not be available until 8:00 A.M. on January 6, 2026.

As a bidder, you must register, set up to bid, and review each solicitation you intend to bid electronically on or before bidding date. **Note:** Navigation of the Bid Express service is FREE unless you select a solicitation for bidding and complete your purchase.

Each bidder is required to furnish with its proposal a Bid Guaranty in accordance with Section 153.54 of the Ohio Revised Code. Bid security furnished in Bond form shall be issued by a surety company or corporation licensed in the State of Ohio to provide said surety.
