Serving more than 50,000 residents, the Dublin Police Department protects, responds to and partners with our Exceptional Community.

## Goals

- ✔ Enhance our readiness and demonstrate our ability to effectively respond to and successfully resolve critical incidents and/or major crimes
- ✔ Reduce theft offenses throughout the city
- ✔ Improve overall traffic safety in the city
- ✔ Enhance and demonstrate our ability to effectively address issues of significant community concern



## Crime Update

- Overall thefts decreased significantly from 2024
- Thefts from vehicles decreased 39%
- OVI crashes decreased, OVI arrests increased
- B&E offenses decreased by more than 50%

## New Programs & Initiatives

- Launched the Drone as First Responder (DFR) program, the largest in Central Ohio.
- Introduced the Business District Unit, a dedicated team of officers providing proactive policing in the city's growing mixed-use areas.

## Community Outreach & Partnerships

- Heroes & Helpers connected officers with dozens of local families facing hardship during the holidays.
- Advanced Safe Space Dublin through continued partnerships and public awareness efforts.
- Hundreds of residents attended the National Night Out community cookout at the Dublin Justice Center.
- Strengthened coordination with Washington Township Fire Department and Dublin City Schools to enhance community safety and support.
