# Agency Quarterly Activity

July – September 2025

## Focus & Results

### Goal #1: Enhance our readiness and demonstrate our ability to effectively respond to and successfully resolve critical incidents and/or major crimes

- Total Part I violent crimes YTD increased by one from 2024 (2025=21; 2024=20)
- 11.8% decrease in reported crimes YTD from 2024 (2025=307; 2024=348)
- Successfully responded to changing crime trends identified in the city

### Goal #2: Reduce theft offenses throughout the city

- 13.9% decrease in theft offenses from 2024 YTD (2025=173; 2024=201)
- 33.3% decrease in thefts from vehicles from 2024 YTD (2025=60; 2024=90)
- 21.3% increase in motor vehicle theft or attempts from 2024 YTD (2025=57; 2024=47)
- 32.5% decrease in burglaries and B&Es from 2023 YTD (2025=27; 2024=40)

### Goal #3: Improve overall traffic safety in the city

- 4.4% increase in traffic crashes from 2024 YTD (2025=570; 2024=546)
- Serious injury traffic crashes increased from 2024 YTD (2025=18; 2024=12)
- 6.3% decrease in OVI related traffic crashes from 2024 YTD (2025=15; 2024=16)
- 10.6% increase in OVI related arrests from 2024 YTD (2025=146; 2024=132)

### Goal #4: Enhance and demonstrate our ability to effectively address issues of significant community concern

The department continues to target areas that have seen an increase in theft from vehicle activity, complaints related to parking garages in the Historic Dublin and Bridge Park areas and continue enforcement efforts throughout the city with traffic and/or speeding concerns.




## CALLS FOR SERVICE

JULY 1, 2025 - SEPTEMBER 30, 2025



## July - September 2025 Other Reported Activity




# City of Dublin - Police Department - Organizational Chart - Standard 11.1.1





# ACCIDENT ANALYSIS

## July - September 2025

July 1, 2025 through September 30, 2025 there were 198 reported traffic accidents, resulting in an average 2.15 accidents/day. Compared to 2024, accidents increased 5.3% (2025 = 198; 2024 = 188).

Personal injury accidents (61) accounted for 30.8% of the total. Property damage accidents accounted for the majority of our activity with 137 reports being filed (69.2%).


District 2 and District 5 experienced the majority of accidents (67 or 33.8% each) followed by District 4 with 29 accidents (14.6%). There were 18 collisions in District 1 (9.1%); 9 collisions in District 3 (4.5%); 7 collisions in District 6 (3.5%); and 1 accident in District Other (0.5%). The busiest day of the week for accident activity for the reporting period was Wednesday with 37 accidents (18.7%) reported. The second busiest day was Thursday with 34 accidents (17.2%) reported. Accident activity for the remaining days of the week were as follows: Sunday = 19 (9.6%); Monday = 27 (13.6%); Tuesday = 28 (14.1%); Friday = 27 (13.6%); and Saturday = 26 (13.1%).

The most frequent contributing factor was Following Too Closely which accounted for 59 or 29.8% of the accidents. The next most recurrent contributing factor was Failure To Yield accounting for 31 or 15.7% of the accidents for the reporting period. The busiest time of day for accident activity was between 3PM-4PM with 20 accidents (10.1%) accidents.





# ACCIDENT ANALYSIS

## January - September 2025

January 1, 2025 through September 30, 2025 there were 570 reported traffic accidents, resulting in an average 2.08 accidents/day. Compared to 2024, accidents increased 4.4% (2025 = 570; 2024 = 546).

Personal injury accidents (163) accounted for 28.6% of the total (1 fatal). Property damage accidents accounted for the majority of our activity with 407 reports being filed (71.4%).


District 5 experienced the majority of accidents (187 or 32.8%) followed by District 2 with 170 accidents (29.8%). There were 69 collisions in District 1 (12.1%); 30 collisions in District 3 (5.3%); 81 collisions in District 4 (14.2%); 32 collisions in District 6 (5.6%); and 1 collision occurring in District Other (0.2%). The busiest day of the week for accident activity for the reporting period was Wednesday with 97 accidents (17.0%) reported. The second busiest day was Thursday with 95 accidents (16.7%) reported. Accident activity for the remaining days of the week were as follows: Sunday = 59 (10.4%); Monday = 79 (13.9%); Tuesday = 85 (14.9%); Friday = 83 (14.6%); and Saturday = 77 (13.6%).

The most frequent contributing factor was Following Too Closely which accounted for 151 or 26.5% of the accidents. The next most recurrent contributing factor was Failure To Yield accounting for 99 or 17.43% of the accidents for the reporting period. The busiest time of day for accident activity was tied between 3PM-4PM and 4PM-5PM each with 54 (9.5%) accidents.


