

NOTICE: SEWER SMOKE TESTING

PROPERTY OWNER OR TENANT: In order to improve service, sanitary sewer lines in this area are being inspected for leaks by means of a non-toxic process known as smoke testing. The City of Dublin has commissioned EMH&T to complete this testing.

EMH&T WILL BE SMOKE TESTING THE SANITARY SEWERS IN THIS AREA ON AUGUST 24, 2026. SEWERS WILL BE FILLED WITH NON-TOXIC SMOKE TO DETECT LOCATIONS WHERE RAINWATER IS ENTERING THE SANITARY SEWER SYSTEM.

The smoke should not get into the building if the internal plumbing is free of defects and in normal working condition. To reduce the chance of the smoke entering the building, make sure that drain traps are full of water. To do this, pour one gallon of water down the floor drain and any other seldom used drain. The smoke used is white with a slight odor and is non-combustible, non-toxic and leaves no residue. A Safety Data Sheet for the smoke product is on file at the City for anyone interested.

RESIDENTS WITH PRE-EXISTING SKIN, RESPIRATORY, PULMONARY OR LUNG DISORDERS SHOULD USE CAUTION AND AVOID CONTACT WITH THE SMOKE. ANYONE ON OXYGEN SHOULD NOTIFY MICHAEL HENDERSHOT WITH THE CITY OF DUBLIN AT 614.410.4657.

Workers may be required to access backyard easements, as some manholes are located there. PLEASE KEEP PETS CONTROLLED DURING THE FEW DAYS THAT WORKERS ARE IN YOUR AREA. Homeowners do not need to be home, and workers will not need to enter your home.
