Questions & Answers #2

1. **What is the preferred square footage for the tent/changing area?**

The City does not have a specific preferred square footage for the tent/changing area. The proposer should determine the appropriate size based on the anticipated number of users, operational needs, and proposed rink layout. The City will review the proposed layout as part of the overall proposal.

2. **What square footage of rubber flooring is required?**

The City does not have a specific square footage requirement for rubber flooring. The proposer should provide sufficient flooring to accommodate the changing area and other areas where temporary flooring is necessary to protect the plaza surface and provide a safe transition around the rink. The proposed amount should be identified in the proposal.

3. **Will the City provide a tax-exempt certificate for equipment purchases related to this contract?**

The City can provide its tax-exempt documentation where applicable. However, the proposer is responsible for determining the applicability of any sales or use tax and should account for all applicable taxes and costs in its proposal.

4. **May we submit with a named installation and management subcontractor's references to satisfy the three-project requirement, or must the prime contractor have completed those installations and management projects directly?**

The City will allow relevant experience and references from a proposed installation and/or management subcontractor to satisfy the project requirement, provided the subcontractor is identified in the proposal and its specific role and responsibilities are clearly described. The City reserves the right to evaluate the qualifications and experience of both the prime contractor and proposed subcontractors as part of the overall proposal.
