Focus & Results

Goal #1: Enhance our readiness and demonstrate our ability to effectively respond to and successfully resolve critical incidents, major crimes, and/or issues of significant community concern.

- 31.3% decrease in violent crimes YTD from 2015
- 17.5% increase in reported crimes YTD from 2015

Goal #2: Reduce theft offenses throughout the city.

- 1.0% decrease in theft offenses from 2015 YTD
- 8.3% decrease in thefts from vehicles from 2015 YTD
- 22.9% increase in burglaries and B&Es from 2015 YTD

Goal #3: Improve overall traffic safety in the city.

- 1.0% decrease in traffic crashes from 2015 YTD
- 0.7% increase in injury traffic crashes from 2015 YTD
- 22.2% increase in OVI related traffic crashes from 2015 YTD

Goal #4: Enhance and demonstrate our ability to effectively address drug offenses that contribute to crime affecting the city.

- 116 criminal arrests related to drug activity; 156 drug offense charges YTD

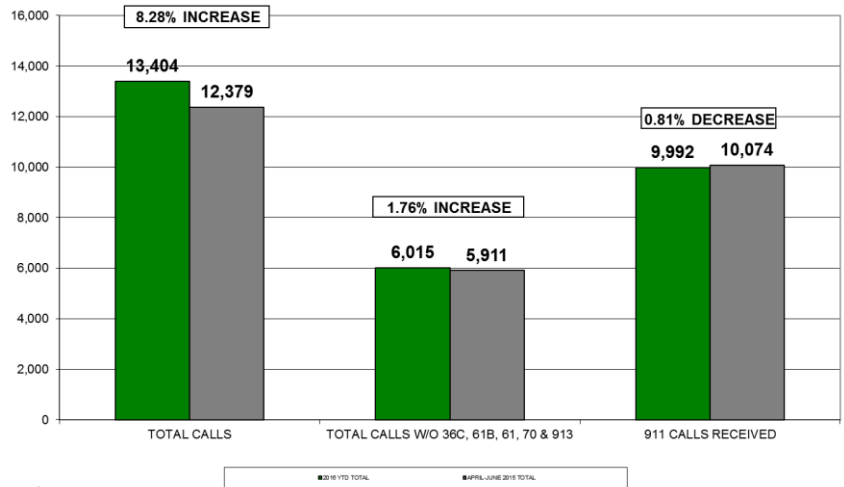

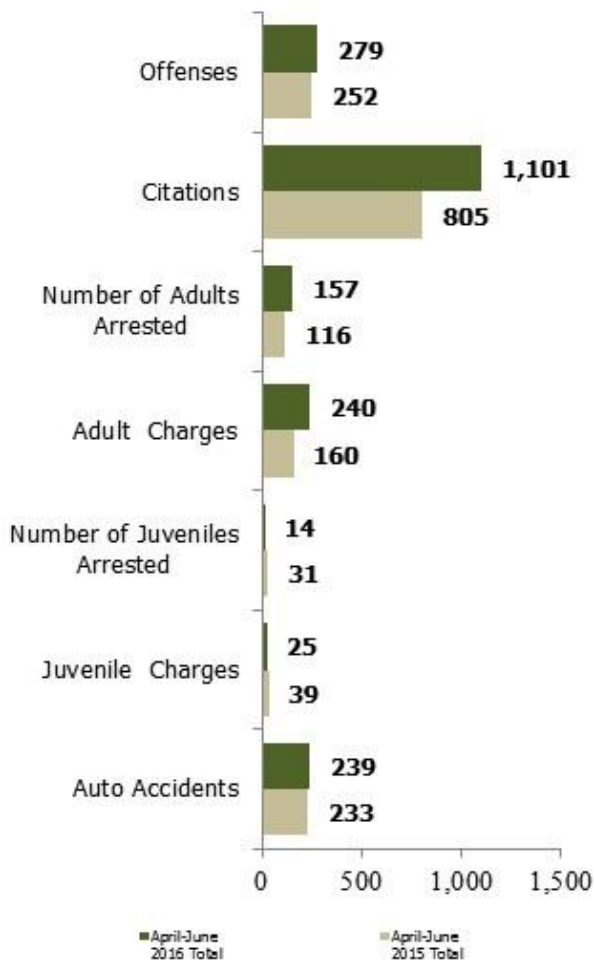

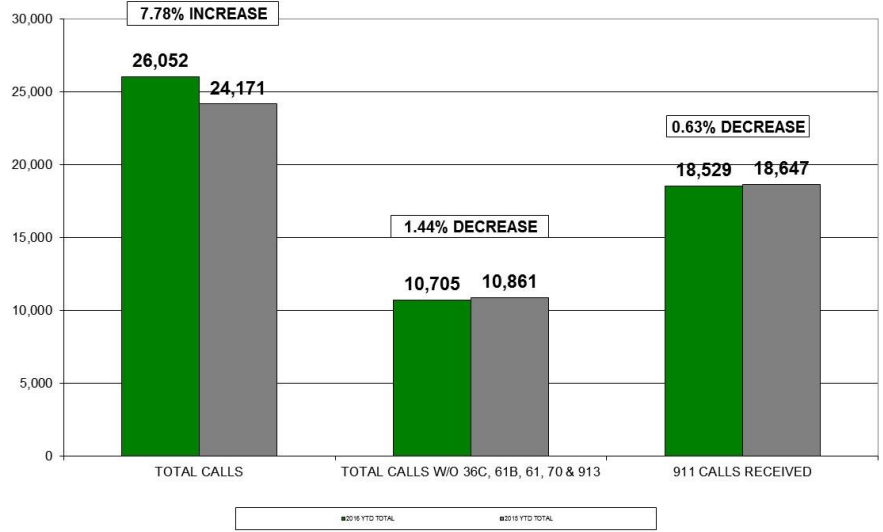

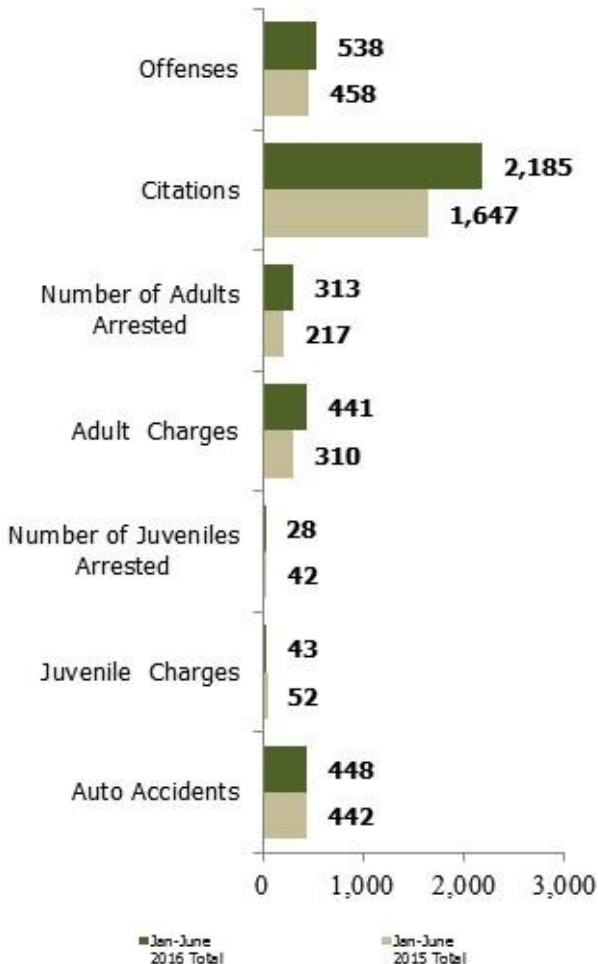
CALLS FOR SERVICE JANUARY 1, 2016 - JUNE 30, 2016



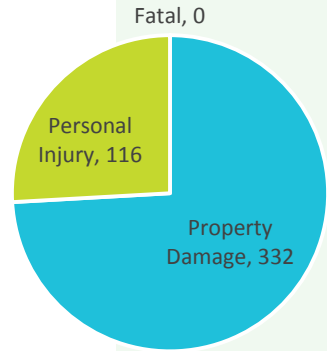
