Focus & Results

Goal #1: Enhance our readiness and demonstrate our ability to effectively respond to and successfully resolve critical incidents, major crimes, and/or issues of significant community concern.

- 30.0% decrease in violent crimes YTD from 2015
- 14.9% increase in reported crimes YTD from 2015

Goal #2: Reduce theft offenses throughout the city.

- 0.3% decrease in theft offenses from 2015 YTD
- 15.3% decrease in thefts from vehicles from 2015 YTD
- 0.0% increase/decrease in burglaries and B&Es from 2015 YTD

Goal #3: Improve overall traffic safety in the city.

- 0.1% increase in traffic crashes from 2015 YTD
- 19.5% decrease in injury traffic crashes from 2015 YTD
- 183.3% increase in OVI related traffic crashes from 2015 YTD

Goal #4: Enhance and demonstrate our ability to effectively address drug offenses that contribute to crime affecting the city.

- 143 criminal arrests related to drug activity; 197 drug offense charges YTD

Through this effort he has provided life saving training to over 1,000 civilians and has received many positive comments. 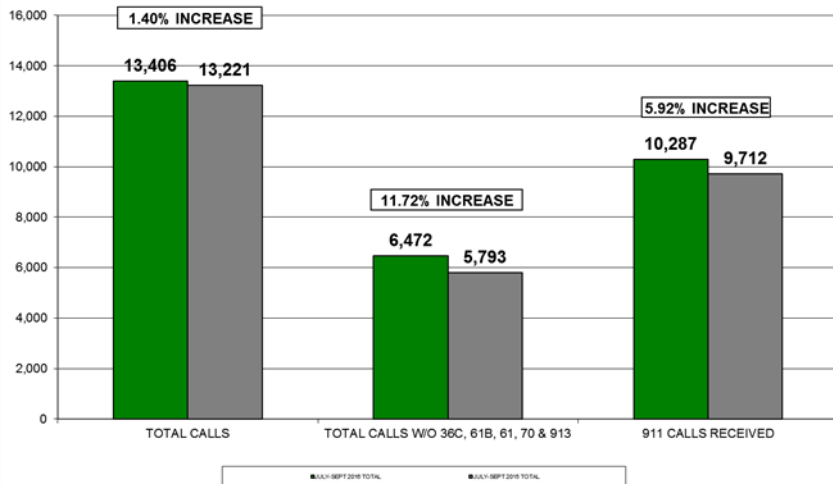

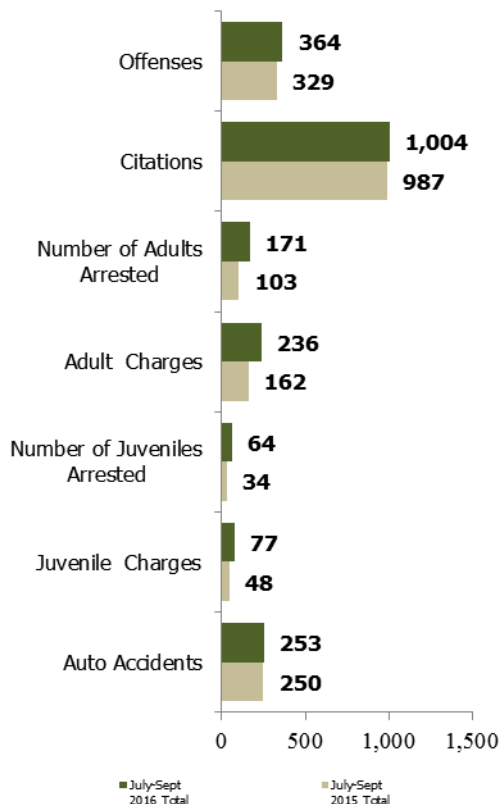

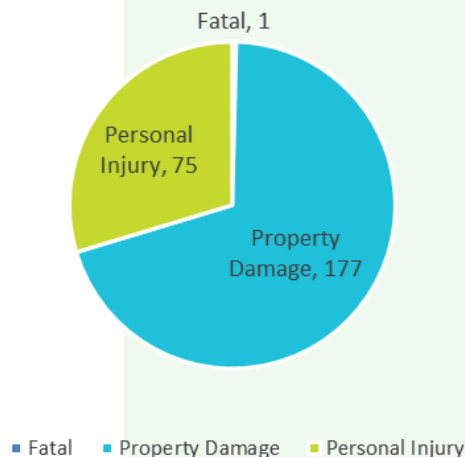
CALLS FOR SERVICE JULY 1, 2016 - SEPTEMBER 30, 2016

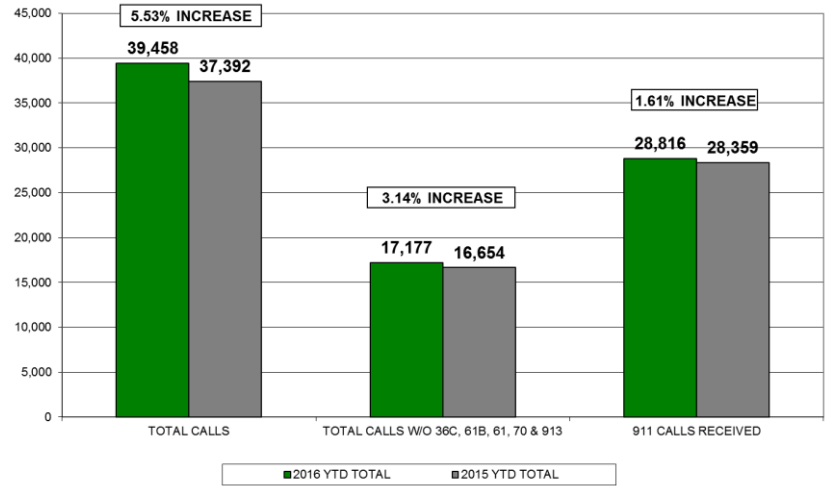

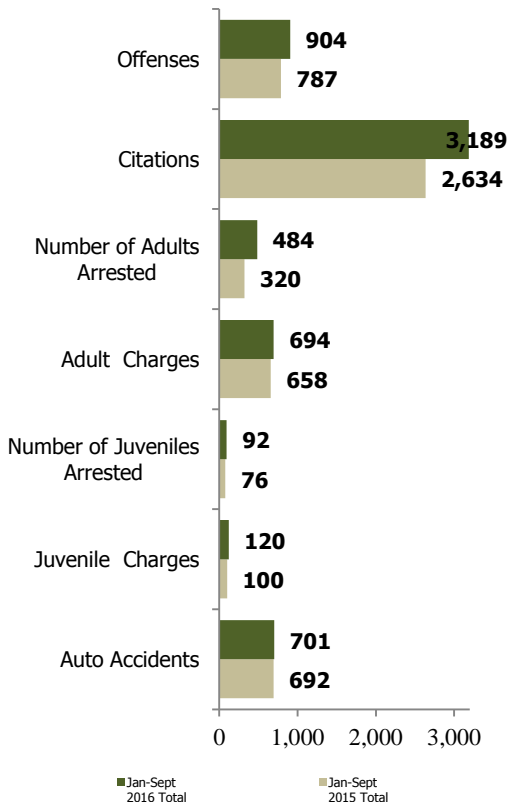

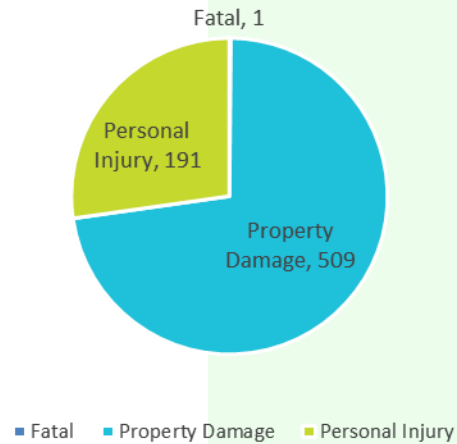
CALLS FOR SERVICE

Auto Accidents



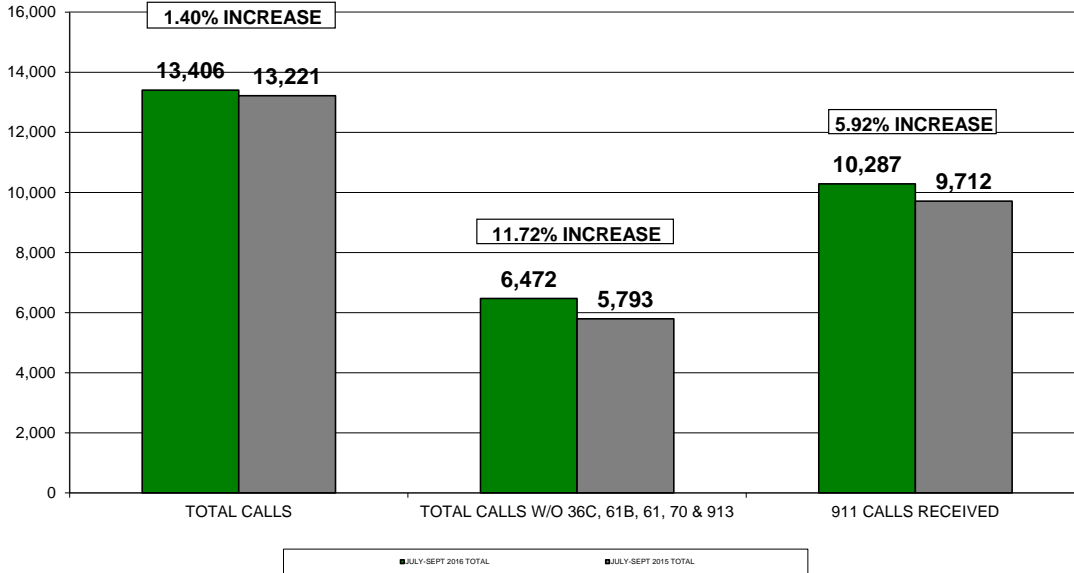

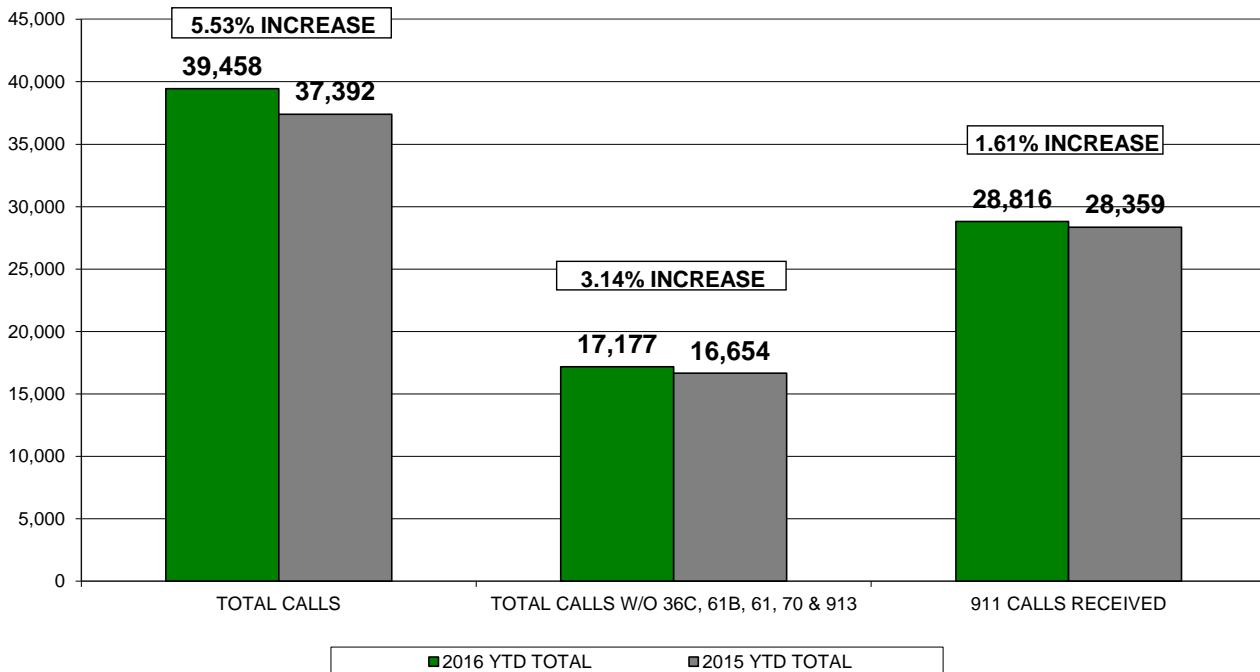

ACCIDENT ANALYSIS July - September 2016

July 1, 2016 through September 30, 2016 there were 253 reported traffic accidents, resulting in an average 2.75 accidents/day. Compared to 2015, accidents increased 1.20% (2016 = 253; 2015 = 250).

Personal injury accidents (76) accounted for 30.04% of the total. Property damage accidents accounted for the majority of our activity with 177 reports being filed (69.96%).

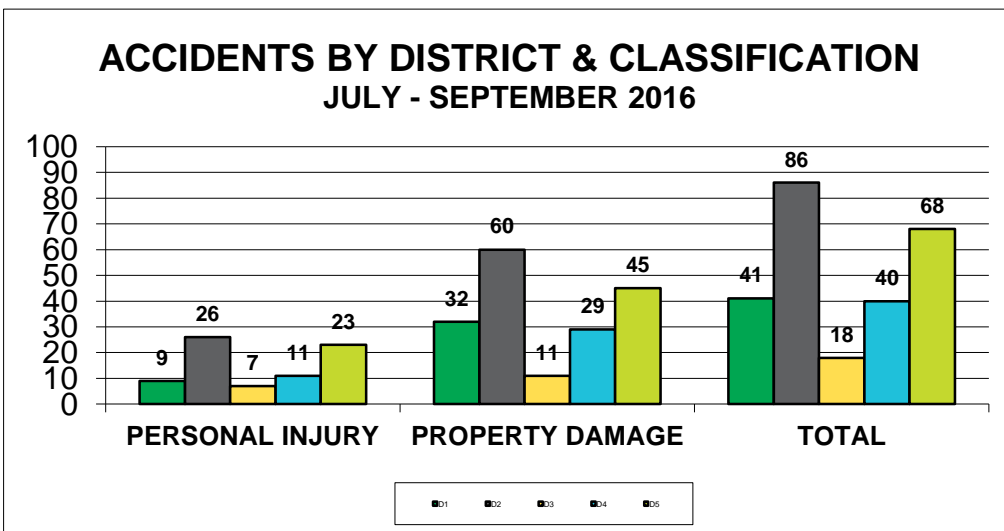
District 2 experienced the majority of accidents (86 or 34.0%) followed by District 5 with 68 accidents (26.9%). There were 41 collisions each in District 1 (16.2%), 18 collision in District 3 (7.1%) and 40 collisions in District 4 (15.8%). The busiest day of the week for accident activity for the reporting period was Friday with 50 accidents (19.8%) reported. The second busiest day was Tuesday with 45 accidents (17.8%) reported. Accident activity for the remaining days of the week were as follows: Sunday = 20 (7.9%); Monday = 35 (13.8%); Wednesday = 44 (17.4%); Thursday = 37 (14.6%); and Saturday = 22 (8.7%).

The most frequent contributing factor was Following Too Closely, which accounted for 71 or 28.1% of the accidents. The next most recurrent contributing factor was Improper Lane Change accounting for 52 or 20.6% of the accidents for the reporting period. The busiest time of day for accident activity was between 5PM-6PM with 39 (15.4%) accidents.

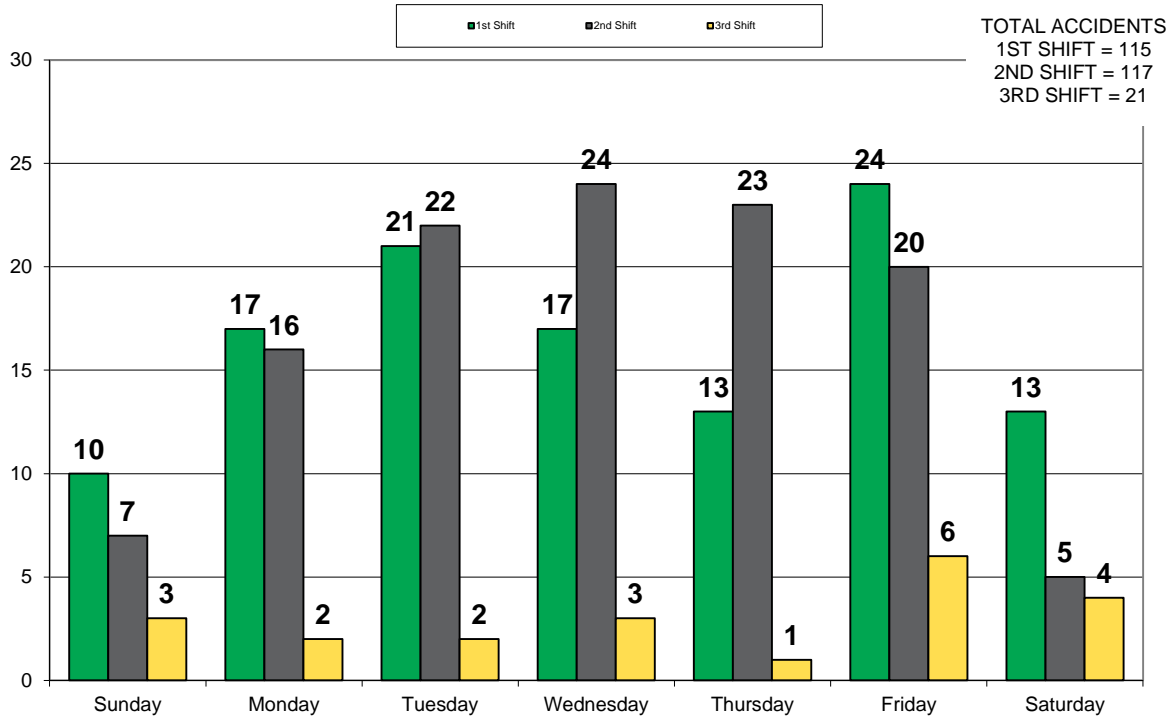
Ten (10) crashes were identified as having been alcohol related (4.0%). The drivers in these accidents were arrested and charged with OVI. Two hundred eighteen (218) citations were issued to at fault drivers as a result of their accidents (86.2%).

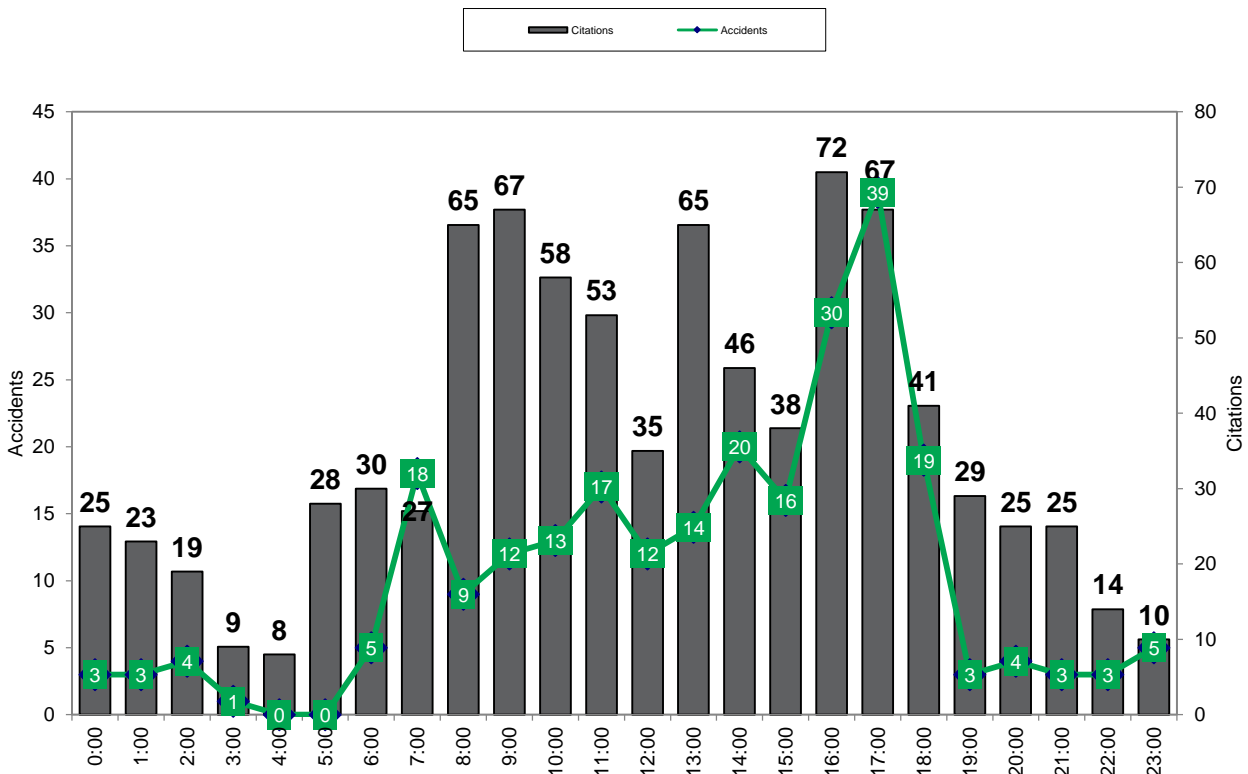

ACCIDENT ANALYSIS January - September 2016

January 1, 2016 through September 30, 2016 there were 701 reported traffic accidents, resulting in an average 2.57 accidents/day. Compared to 2015, accidents increased 1.30% (2016 = 701; 2015 = 692).

Personal injury accidents (192) accounted for 27.4% of the total. Property damage accidents accounted for the majority of our activity with 509 reports being filed (72.6%).

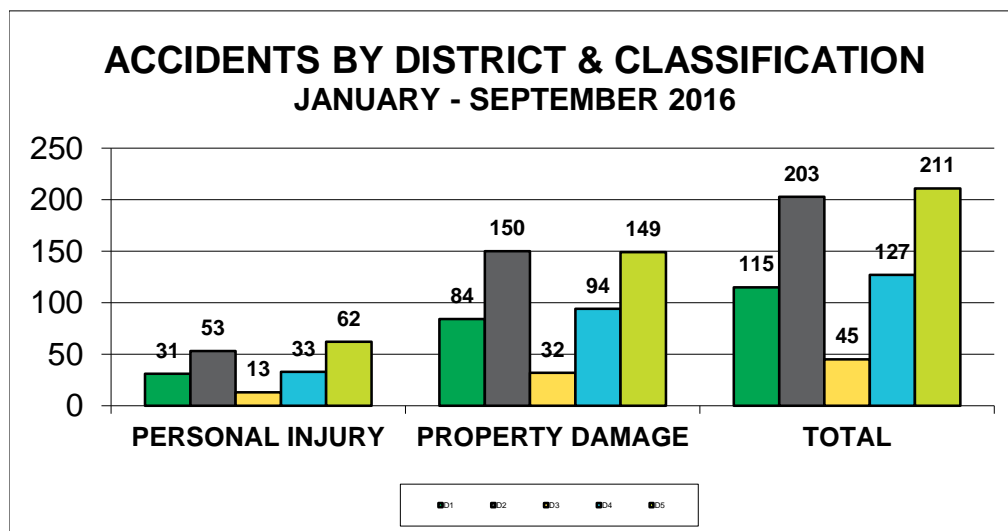
District 5 experienced the majority of accidents (211 or 30.1%) followed by District 2 with 203 accidents (29.0%). There were 115 collisions in District 1 (16.4%), 45 collisions in District 3 (6.4%) and in District 4, 127 accidents (18.1%). The busiest day of the week for accident activity for the reporting period was Friday with 132 accidents (18.8%) reported. The next busiest day was Tuesday with 122 accidents (17.4%) reported. Accident activity for the remaining days of the week were as follows: Sunday = 56 (8.0%); Monday = 98 (14.0%); Wednesday = 114 (16.3%); Thursday = 107 (15.3%) and Saturday = 72 (10.3%).

The most frequent contributing factor was Following Too Closely, which accounted for 238 or 34.0% of the accidents. The next most recurrent contributing factor was Failure To Yield (99 or 14.1%) followed by Failure To Control accounting for 92 or 13.1% of the accidents for the reporting period. The busiest time of day for accident activity was between 5PM-6PM with 90 (12.8%) accidents.

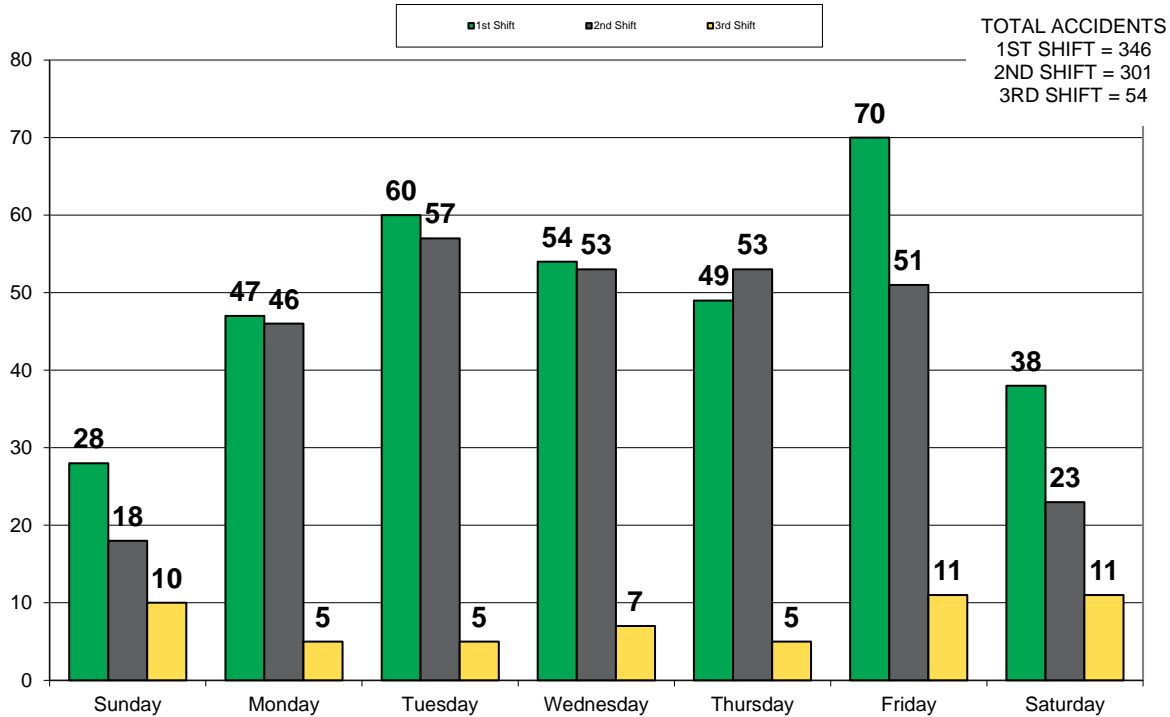
Nineteen (19) crashes were identified as having been alcohol related (2.7%). The drivers in these accidents were arrested and charged with OVI. Five hundred eighty-one (581) citations were issued to at fault drivers as a result of their accidents (82.9%).

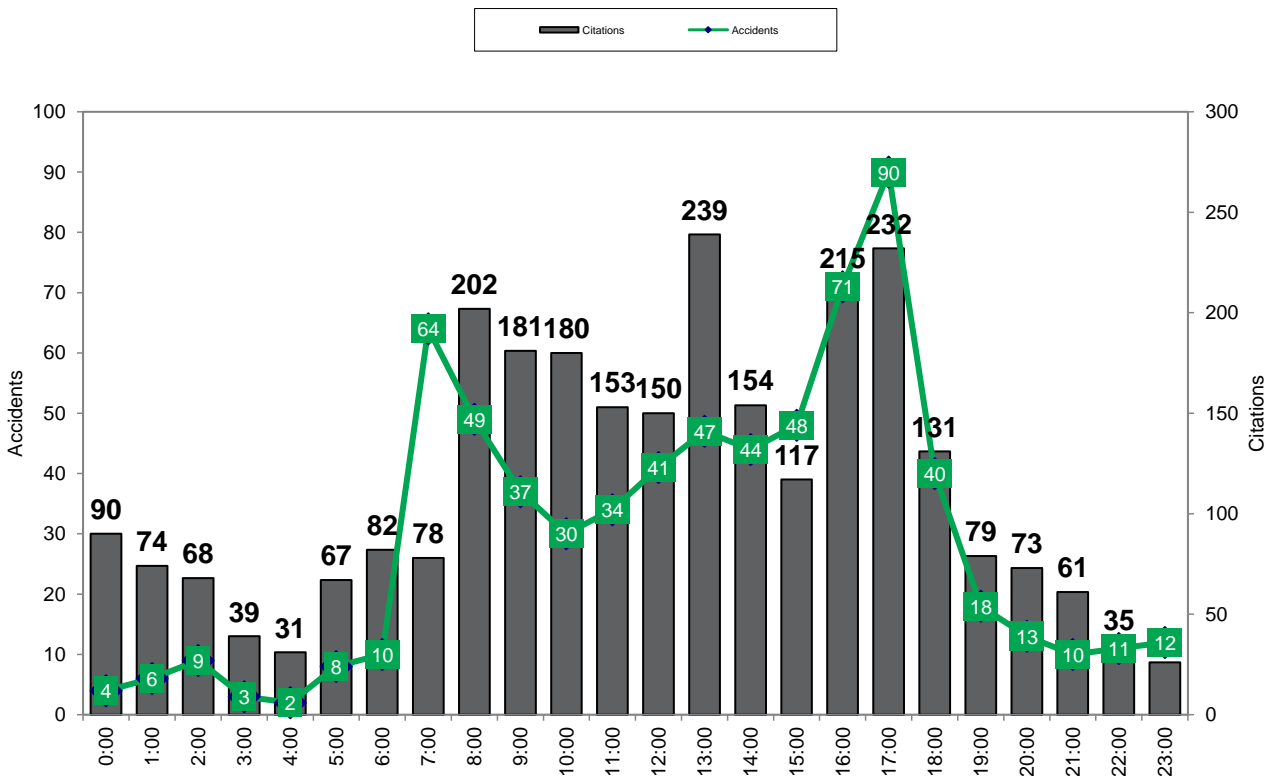

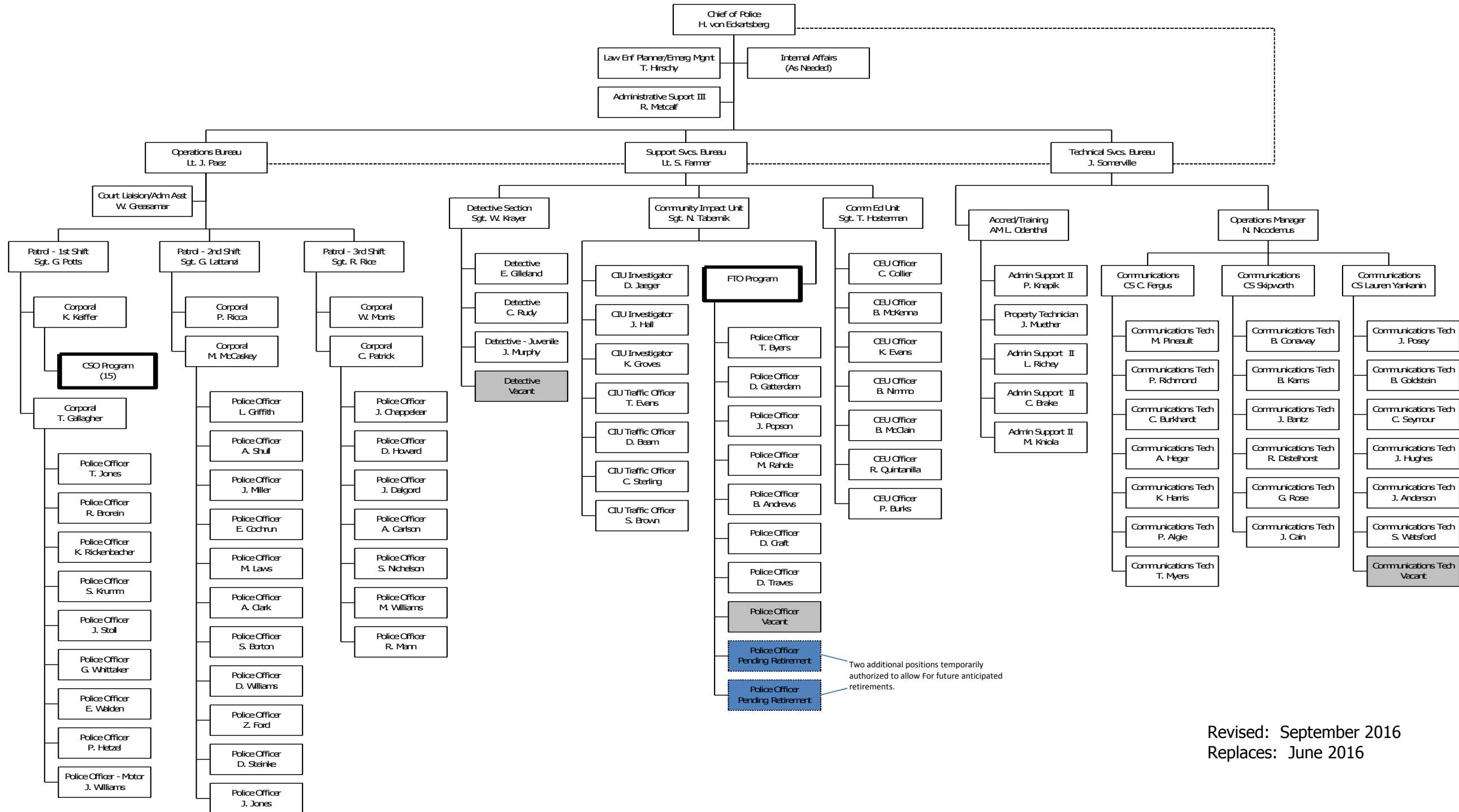
ACCIDENTS BY DAY OF WEEK & SHIFT JANUARY 1 - SEPTEMBER 30, 2016
