DCPN Lap/Competition Pool Requests

1. Replace 25 Meter Pool – Outdoor Only

2. 25 Meter - “Bubble” Enclosure – Team Practices, Lap Swimming, etc.
3. 25 Meter - Indoor/Outdoor Retractable Enclosure
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4. Replace with 50 Meter Outdoor Pool Without Enclosure
5. Replace with 50 Meter Indoor/Outdoor Retractable Enclosure
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6. Natatorium – Another Location?
