#### **HISTORIC DUBLIN BUSINESS**

In the City of Dublin, we are constantly working to improve and maintain the quality of our infrastructure and amenities. That includes preserving the appearance and integrity of the brick sidewalks in Dublin's Historic District.

This year, the sidewalk in front of your property has been selected for restoration. This flyer is designed to help inform and prepare you for the process.

## During the brick maintenance process, you can expect the following actions:

- 1. Pressure washing
- 2. Sanding the brick joints
- 3. Brick repositioning and/ or replacement in designated areas
- 4. Site clean-up and restoration

#### **TENTATIVE SCHEDULE**

The City has contracted with Environmental Management Inc. for this project. The contractor plans to start work as soon as **Wednesday**, **November 13**, **2019**. The project is expected to take approximately one month to complete, but crews anticipate being in most areas for only a few days.

Please see the map on the other side of this flier. The areas lined in red will be pressure washed and sanded. The areas marked with green stars will include brick repairs, which will take a little longer and involve short-term sidewalk closures. Crews will work to maintain access to all businesses.

#### **PARKING RESTRICTIONS**

On-street parking restrictions are possible in some locations. "No parking" signs will be placed ahead of time when necessary.

#### TRAFFIC IMPACTS

Between 8:30 a.m. and 4 p.m., there may be brief, intermittent lane restrictions in the area. Electronic arrow boards will be used to direct traffic when necessary. A portion of Darby Street may be closed during certain times as necessary for equipment staging.
