Re: Resolution No. 42-20 – Affirming that funds distributed under Amended

Substitute House Bill 481 shall be expended by the City only for costs permitted under the Federal Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act and Repealing and Replacing Resolution 34-20

Summary

This resolution corrects a clerical error in the previous resolution. This clerical error and its subsequent correction will not have an impact on the City's ability to access CARES Act funding.

The adoption of this resolution is required for the City to receive its allocation of federal relief funding from the State of Ohio. The City estimates it will receive \$330,000 from this initial allocation of funding.

On March 27, 2020 the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES) was signed into law by the President of the United States. As part of that federal legislation, \$4.6 billion was allocated to the State of Ohio. Of this amount \$2.0 billion will be distributed to local governments with \$775 million going to local governments with a population of over 500,000. Of the remaining \$1.2 billion, \$350 million will be distributed utilizing a county's undivided local government fund formula as required by Ohio Amended Substitute House Bill 481. The distribution formula and timing of remaining \$850 million has yet to be determined.

Recommendation

Staff is requesting approval of Resolution No. 42-20 at the July 27, 2020 Council meeting.

A RESOLUTION AFFIRMING THAT FUNDS DISTRIBUTED UNDER AMENDED SUBSTITUTE HOUSE BILL 481 BY THE STATE OF OHIO TO THE CITY OF DUBLIN SHALL BE EXPENDED BY THE CITY ONLY FOR COSTS PERMITTED UNDER THE FEDERAL CORONAVIRUS AID, RELIEF, AND ECONOMIC SECURITY ACT AND REPEALING AND REPLACING RESOLUTION 34-20.

WHEREAS, the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act, 116 Public Law 136, ("CARES Act") was signed into law by the President of the United States on March 27, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio General Assembly established a process for distributing funds provided by the CARES Act in Amended Substitute House Bill 481 of the 133rd General Assembly (H.B. 481); and

WHEREAS, H.B. 481 requires subdivisions receiving funds under Section 1 of the Act, to pass a resolution affirming that funds from the County Coronavirus Relief Distribution Fund may be expended only to cover costs of the subdivision consistent with the requirements of Section 5001 of the CARES Act as described in 42 U.S.C. 801 (formerly 42 U.S.C. 601), and any applicable regulations before receiving said funds; and

WHEREAS, Dublin is requesting its share of funds from the County Coronavirus Relief Distribution Fund; and

WHEREAS, Dublin passed Resolution 34-20 for the same purpose as this Resolution but included a clerical error referencing the incorrect House Bill; and

WHEREAS, Dublin City Council believes that accepting such funds pursuant to the required conditions is in the best interest of the public health, safety, and welfare of the City of Dublin.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Dublin, State of Ohio, _____ of the elected members concurring that:

<u>Section 1</u>: The City hereby repeals Resolution 34-20 and replaces it with this Resolution which adopts the same terms with correct statutory references.

<u>Section 2</u>: The City affirms that all funds received from the County Coronavirus Relief Distribution Fund pursuant to H.B. 481 shall be expended only to cover costs of the city consistent with the requirements of Section 5001 of the CARES Act as described in 42 U.S.C. 801 (formerly 42 U.S.C. 601), and outlined more specifically in Section 3.

<u>Section 3</u>: The City shall spend funds received under H.B. 481 only on necessary expenditures incurred due to COVID-19 between March 1, 2020 and December 30, 2020 that were not accounted for in Dublin's most recently approved budget as of March 27, 2020.

<u>Section 4</u>: If any federal or state revisions are made to the local expenditure requirements, the City affirms that it will use all funds received from the County Coronavirus Relief Distribution Fund consistent with those revisions.
