






The Dublin Police has partnered with Columbus Public Health to distribute lock boxes to help limit access to lethal means in homes.


## City of Dublin - Police Department - Organizational Chart - Standard 11.1.1



# **ACCIDENT ANALYSIS January - March 2021**

January 1, 2021 through March 31, 2021 there were 100 reported traffic accidents, resulting in an average 1.11 accidents/day. Compared to 2020, accidents decreased 38.7% (2021 = 100; 2020 = 163).

Personal injury accidents (23) accounted for 23.0% of the total. Property damage accidents accounted for the majority of our activity with 77 reports being filed (77.0%).


District 2 experienced the majority of accidents (34 or 34.0%) followed by District 4 with 24 accidents (24.0%). There were 7 collisions in District 1 (7.0%); 5 collisions in District 3 (5.0%); 21 collisions in District 5 (21.0%); and 9 collisions in District 6 (9.0%). The busiest day of the week for accident activity for the reporting period was Sunday with 19 accidents (19.0%) reported. The second busiest day was Wednesday with 18 accidents (18.0%) reported. Accident activity for the remaining days of the week were as follows: Monday = 17 (17.0%); Tuesday = 10 (10.0%); Thursday = 11 (11.0%); Friday = 13 (13.0%); and Saturday = 12 (12.0%).

The most frequent contributing factor was Other Improper Action which accounted for 18 or 18.0% of the accidents. The next most recurrent contributing factor was Failure To Yield accounting for 17 or 17.0% of the accidents for the reporting period. The busiest time of day for accident activity was between 4PM-5PM with 9 (9.0%) accidents.


Five (5) crashes were identified as having been alcohol related (5.0%). The drivers in these accidents were arrested and charged with OVI. Seventy-three (73) citations were issued to at fault drivers as a result of their accidents 73.0%
