

Hanukkah Menorah Art

Supplies:

- Sponge
- Tempera paints
- Cardstock paper
- Paper plate
- Scissors



Directions:

1. Cut the sponge by making geometric shapes or cut apart free-flowing forms.
2. Pour a few pools of paints on the paper plate.
3. Dip a sponge piece into the paint, coating one side completely. Press it onto the paper to make a print.
4. Repeat the paint print step, making a menorah. Your child can design whatever type of menorah he or she can imagine!
5. Add nine candles to the top of the menorah. Use a thin rectangle-shaped sponge to do this. The middle candle (the shamash) is used to light the others. This one can be a bit taller than the rest of the candles.
6. Paint a flame on for each night of Hanukkah. Go back to the art activity each night, adding a new yellow top to each candle with yellow tempera paint.
