Re: Throw Nation LLC Ownership Transfer Application for D5 and D6 Liquor Permits

### I. INTRODUCTION

The City of Dublin recently received a Notice to Legislative Authority ("Notice") from the Ohio Division of Liquor Control concerning a transfer of ownership application for D5 and D6 liquor permits from Axe Throwing LLC ("Axe Throwing") to Throw Nation Columbus LLC ("Throw Nation"). Dublin received this Notice pursuant to R.C. 4303.26 because the location of the permit premises is within the corporate limits of Dublin. As such, Dublin may request a hearing regarding the advisability of the issuance, transfer of ownership, or transfer of location of the permit.

# II. BACKGROUND

Throw Nation is a domestic limited liability company that is actively registered with the Ohio Secretary of State. The address designated for the permit premises is 6649 Dublin Center Drive, Dublin, Ohio 43017, which is located off Sawmill Road just south of Interstate 270 in the Dublin Village Center. The location remains the same as it was under the ownership of Axe Throwing, LLC.

Throw Nation is seeking a transfer of a D5 liquor permit, which permits spirituous liquor for on premises consumption only, and beer, wine, and mixed beverages for on premises or off premises consumption in original sealed containers, until 2:30am, and a D6 permit, which permits the sale of intoxicating liquor on Sunday between the hours of 10:00am and midnight. The application is currently pending before the Division.

According to the Division's records, Throw Nation does not have a history of violating Ohio liquor permit laws. In 2019, when Axe Throwing LLC initially obtained the permits, Council requested a hearing because of concerns regarding the mixing of the activity and alcohol. However, since the permits were initially issued there have not been any incidents of note at the premises.

# III. RECOMMENDATION

It does not appear necessary to request a hearing on this application. This application has been submitted because of a change in ownership, but the new owner has a history of operating similar establishments without incident.

Regardless of whether Dublin desires to request a hearing, the Notice must be signed and returned to the Ohio Division of Liquor Control by January 31, 2022.
