



INVITATION FOR BIDS

Project Name: Kiwanis Park Boardwalk Design/Build Project No. 22-006-PRD

The City of Dublin, Ohio will receive electronic bids from a licensed and qualified Design / Build Contractor, Contractor and hired design professional capable of sealing drawings for permitting, or other combination that can deliver a drawing package that can obtain a building permit and then construct those improvements. The proposal / quote should include two quotes: 1. The Design and permitting of the project by a licensed professional and 2. The construction of the designed and permitted drawings, including all materials and labor necessary to repair, refurbish, and install new boardwalks at Kiwanis Park. The park is located at 6245 Riverside Drive, Dublin, Ohio 43017 (Note: Property owned by the City of Columbus, Ohio). This project includes design plan and detailing for permitting, selective site clearing, minor grading at boardwalk piers, earth / rock spoils removal, concrete landings at the ends of boardwalks, asphalt paths, pressure treated wood boardwalks (add alt. using composite decking on boardwalks), native landscape planting, and site restoration. Contractor will need to work with City of Dublin / Columbus Staff throughout the project to finalize construction details and work through the environmentally sensitive areas of the site.

Bids shall be received by the City of Dublin via the Bid Express ® service at www.bidexpress.com until 10:00 A.M. local time on Tuesday, August 9, 2022. Bid documents will not be available until 8:00 A.M. on Tuesday, July 19, 2022.

The City of Dublin will also be holding a pre-bid meeting at the Service Center (6555 Shier Rings Road, Dublin, Ohio 43016) on July 27th at 11:00 am until noon in Conference Room 125.

Documents are available online at www.bidexpress.com at no charge. By downloading these free attachments, you will immediately become a plan holder. This ensures you receive addendums that may be issued.

As a bidder, you must register, set up to bid, and review each solicitation you intend to bid electronically on before bidding. **Note:** Navigation of the Bid Express service is FREE unless you select a solicitation for bidding and complete your purchase.

Each bidder is required to furnish with its proposal a Bid Guaranty in accordance with Section 153.54 of the Ohio Revised Code. Bid security furnished in Bond form shall be issued by a surety company or corporation licensed in the State of Ohio to provide said surety.

The City of Dublin reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids, to waive any informalities or irregularities in the bidding process and to enter into a contract with the bidder whom, in its opinion, offers the lowest and best bid.

Each bidder must ensure that all employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against based on race, color, religion, sex, or national origin.
