RE: Goraya Investments, Inc. - Application for a new C1 and C2¹ Liquor Permit

I. INTRODUCTION

The City of Dublin recently received a Notice to Legislative Authority (“Notice”) from the Ohio Division of Liquor Control (the “Division”) concerning Goraya Investments, Inc. (“Goraya”). Dublin received this Notice pursuant to Ohio Revised Code 4303.26 because Goraya applied for a new C1 and C2 permit and the proposed location for the permit premises is within the corporate limits of Dublin. As such, Dublin may request a hearing regarding the advisability of the issuance, transfer of ownership, or transfer of location of the permit.

II. BACKGROUND

Goraya is a for profit corporation that is actively registered with the Ohio Secretary of State. The location designated for the permit premises is 201 W. Bridge Street, Dublin, Ohio 43017. Goraya is seeking a C1 permit which allows the sale of beer in the original sealed container for carry out. Goraya is also seeking a C2 permit which allows the sale of wine and mixed beverages in sealed containers for carry out. C1 and C2 permits may only be issued to the owner or operator of a retail store for carryout pursuant to Ohio Revised Code 4303. Goraya will have to meet the requirements to obtain the C1 and C2 permit. The Division, and not the City, holds the authority to determine if Goraya is the type of business eligible to receive the C1 and C2 permit.

Goraya’s application for the C1 and C2 permit is currently pending with the Division. According to the Division’s records, Goraya does not have a history of violating Ohio liquor laws.

¹ Goraya also applied to the Division for a D6 permit for the same permit premises. The D6 permit is also pending before the Division. The Notice to the City did not include the D6 permit class.

III. RECOMMENDATION

It appears unnecessary to request a hearing in this matter. Goraya does not have any history of liquor law violations and the State will determine if it meets the remaining eligibility requirements necessary to obtain the C1 and C2 permit. Regardless of whether Dublin desires to request a hearing, the Notice must be signed and returned to the Ohio Division of Liquor Control by September 15, 2022.

- Notify the Division whether you object and want a hearing; or
- Ask for your one-time only, 30-day extension.
 - Any requests for a one-time, 30-day extension will be reviewed by the Division upon timely receipt. If granted, your additional 30-days runs from the expiration of the original 30-day period.
