



INVITATION FOR BIDS

Project Name: Franklin Street Extension

The City of Dublin Ohio will receive electronic bids for the materials and labor necessary for the construction of the Franklin Street Extension Project. Bids shall be received by the City of Dublin via the Bid Express ® service at www.bidexpress.com until 10:00 A.M. local time on Thursday, October 27 2022. Bid documents will not be available until 8:00 A.M. on Wednesday, October 5, 2022.

The City of Dublin may choose to not award the bid—and bidders shall hold bids open—until sixty days after the bid opening. The work for which bids are invited consists of: This project includes extending Franklin Street between Bridge Street and North Street as a two lane roadway with on-street parking. Additionally, Franklin Street will be reconstructed between Sells Alley and Bridge Street to include on-street parking and brick walk. Bridge Street will be widened west of Franklin Street. The project also includes the removal of the pedestrian crossing at Darby Street and Bridge Street and resurfacing of Darby Street. Work Consists of asphalt pavement, resurfacing, brick pavement, permeable pavement, brick walk, granite curbs, storm sewer, street lighting, signal work, traffic control, and landscaping. The cost estimate for the Project is \$3,000,000.00.

As a bidder, you must register, set up to bid, and review each solicitation you intend to bid electronically on before bidding. **Note:** Navigation of the Bid Express service is FREE unless you select a solicitation for bidding and complete your purchase.

Each bidder is required to furnish with its proposal a Bid Guaranty in accordance with Section 153.54 of the Ohio Revised Code. Bid security furnished in Bond form shall be issued by a surety company or corporation licensed in the State of Ohio to provide said surety.

Each proposal must contain the full name of the party or parties submitting the proposal and all persons interested therein. Each bidder must submit evidence of its experience on projects of similar size and complexity. The owner intends and requires that this project be completed by November 1, 2023.

All contractors and subcontractors involved with the project will to the extent practicable use Ohio products, materials, services and labor in the implementation of their project. Payment of Prevailing Wages is required for this Project.

The City of Dublin reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids, to waive any informalities or irregularities in the bidding process and to enter into a contract with the bidder whom, in its opinion, offers the lowest and best bid.

Each bidder must ensure that all employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against based on race, color, religion, sex, or national origin.
